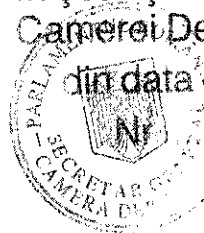

Secretariatul Internațional al Adunării Parlamentare pentru Cooperare Economică a Mării Negre (APCEMN) a transmis delegației permanente a Camerei Deputaților la APCEMN invitația de a participa la cea de a 34-a reuniuni a Comisiei culturale, de educație și probleme sociale a APCEMN care se va desfășura la Moscova, 7-8 aprilie a.c.

Acțiunea are caracter parlamentar conform art.3, litera a) din HBP nr.1/2003 cu modificările și completările din HBP nr. 5/2007.

Propunem:

- să se aprobe participarea membrilor delegației, menționați mai sus, la această acțiune;
- deplasarea să se efectueze cu avionul pe ruta București-Varșovia-Moscova și retur, cu plecare în data de 6.04.2010, ora 6.00, (LO 644) și întoarcere în data de 9.04.2010, ora 13.55 (LO 641),
- să se acorde drepturi de diurnă categoria a II-a, 50% pentru 3 1/2 zile, precum și un avans de 50% cu decontare ulterioară;
- recalcularea cheltuielilor să se facă la întoarcerea în țară, pe baza documentelor justificative.

THIRTY-FOURTH MEETING

MOSCOW

1. The Thirty-Fourth Meeting of the Cultural, Educational and Social Affairs Committee will be held in Moscow, on 7-8 April 2010, at the invitation of the PABSEC Russian Delegation.
2. The main item placed on the agenda is: **“Protecting women against violence in the BSEC Member States”**.
RAPPEUR ON THE REPORT: MRS. RUSUDAN KERVALISHVILI, Member of the Committee (Georgia).
RAPPEUR ON THE RECOMMENDATION 116/2009: Mr. ALEXANDROS DERMENTZOPOULOS, Chairman of the Committee (Greece).
3. In conformity with Article 31.3 of the PABSEC Rules of Procedure, the National Delegations shall forward their contributions for the preparation of documents to the International Secretariat two months ahead of the meeting date. The International Secretariat will forward the relevant documents of the meeting by 8 March 2010.
4. The Draft Minutes of the 33rd Meeting of the Committee, held on 22 October 2009 in Thessaloniki, were circulated to the National Delegations on 10 December 2009. **There will be no distribution of this document in Moscow.** The participants are kindly requested to make sure they have a copy during the meeting.
5. The National Delegations are requested to be prepared to propose the main subject to be placed on the agenda of the next meeting of the Committee.
6. The date and venue of the next meeting shall be decided according to the Decision 5/1997 of the Standing Committee.
7. Following the Decision of the Bureau of 19 June 1997 the host country shall fully cover the board and lodging expenses **only for the members of the Committee and one Secretary from each delegation and the International Secretariat.**
8. The National Delegations are kindly asked to confirm their participation and provide the corresponding arrival/departure details by 22 March 2010.

TO: THE SECRETARIES OF THE NATIONAL DELEGATIONS

9. According to the bilateral intergovernmental agreements on consular issues, a visa is required to enter the Russian Federation. For citizens of Albania, Azerbaijan, Armenia, Bulgaria, Moldova, Romania, Serbia and Ukraine, holders of diplomatic and service passports and also for citizens of Greece and Turkey, holders of diplomatic passports, entry visa are not required.
- The rest of the participants who need an entry visa must obtain it in advance in one of the diplomatic representations of the Russian Federation abroad. In order to provide visa support by the State Duma of the Russian Federation, we kindly ask to fill in the attached form for each of the member of your delegation who needs visa and send it not later than 9 March 2010 to Mrs. Yulia Guskova, International Cooperation Department, the State Duma of the Russian Federation, tel: +749566921747; fax +74956925358; E-mail: guskova@duma.gov.ru
