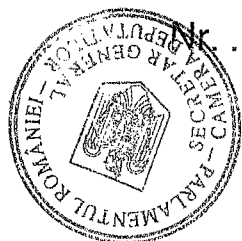


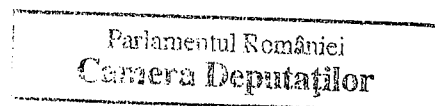

**Tema: Participarea la lucrările celei de-a XX-a ediție a Forumului
Economic (Krynica, Polonia, 8-11 septembrie 2010)**

În perioada 8-11 septembrie 2010 va avea loc la Krynica, Polonia, sub egida Institutului pentru Studii Estice, lucrările celei de-a XX-a ediție a Forumului Economic cu tema „Europa după Tratatul de la Lisabona – Strategie pentru viitor”.

La această acțiune, din partea Camerei Deputaților, a fost invitat să participe domnul deputat Sever Voinescu Cotoi (PD-L), secretar al Biroului permanent al Camerei Deputaților, membru al Comisiei pentru politică externă.

Reuniunea va avea în dezbatere teme precum: „dezvoltarea dialogului și cooperarea în țările membre ale Uniunii Europene cu partenerii și vecinii săi”, „politica economică Europeană”; „politicile internaționale de securitate”, etc.

În cei 18 ani de activitate, Forumul Economic a devenit un eveniment economic major și renumit pentru dezbaterile din diferite domenii de activitate ale vieții sociale, politice, economice și culturale.

Menționăm faptul că, pentru perioada desfășurării efective a reuniunii (8 – 11 septembrie 2010) toate cheltuielile privind cazarea, mesele zilnice și transferurile (Cracovia-Krynica și retur) de la/spre aeroport/hotel sunt suportate de către organizatori.

Acțiunea are caracter parlamentar conform art.3, lit. e) din HBP 1/2003 cu modificările și completările din HBP 5/2007.

Propunem:

- să se aprobe participarea domnului deputat Sever Voinescu Cotoi la această reuniune;
- deplasarea să se efectueze cu avionul, pe ruta București-Munchen-Cracovia și retur, cu plecare în data de 8 septembrie a.c., orele 13.15, zbor LH 3421 și întoarcere în data de 11 septembrie a.c., orele 18.35, zbor LH 3480 ;
- să se acorde drepturi diurnă categoria a II-a, 50% pentru 3 1/2 zile, precum și un avans de 50% cu decontare ulterioară;
- recalcularea cheltuielilor să se efectueze la întoarcerea în țară pe baza documentelor justificative.

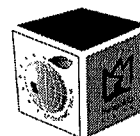

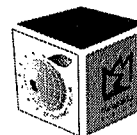

Dear Sir,

I have the pleasure to invite you to participate as a speaker in the 20th Economic Forum in Krynica, Poland, 8-11 September 2010.

The Economic Forum in Krynica is one of the most significant international events in Central Europe. It has been held annually since 1991 by the Warsaw-based Institute for Eastern Studies in the picturesque mountain resort of Krynica in southern Poland. Every year, the Forum brings together high-level participants from more than 60 countries, with the aim of developing dialogue and cooperation among EU countries, their neighbours and partners. The Forum agenda includes some 120 discussion panels that come under 10 thematic tracks including business and investment, European economic policy, energy, geopolitics, international security, the EU & its neighbourhood, and other similar debates.

I would like to invite you to contribute to the discussion panel “**How much does Europe mean for the U.S.? Obama's Foreign Policy and its implications for Europe**” as part of the Forum. It is envisaged that the panel will be comprised of the following speakers:

Seth Cropsey, Senior Fellow, Hudson Institute, US (moderator)

Ana Maria Gomes, Member of the European Parliament, Portugal

Lapo Pistelli, Member of the Committee on Foreign Affairs and European Union Affairs, Parliament of Italy

Milan Pajevic, Chairman of the International Advisory Board, International and Security Affairs Center, Serbia

Thomas Snegaroff, Historian and Commentator, France

Main discussion points:

Obama's effort to “re-set” relations with Russia including the decision not to place ballistic missile defenses in Poland and the Czech Republic;

The tension between the Obama administration's idealism on nuclear weapons policy and its understanding of realpolitik as expressed by the effort to craft great power ententes for managing large international problems, and what role—if any—the US sees for Europe in such great power ententes;

What place Europe should have in US foreign policy including differences between Western and Central/Eastern Europe that could affect relations between the US and Europe.

I truly hope that you will be able to join into this panel and look forward to receiving your reply shortly.

1. REGISTRATION

All conference attendees are required to register online at: www.forum-ekonomiczne.pl

Registration consists of **two stages**.

First

- Fill out and submit online registration form

Upon the completion of the *First* stage of the registration you will receive an automatic reply with an access **CODE** in the form of the link (token). Please click on the link to proceed with the *Second* stage of the registration.

Second

- Attach your photo sized 200x280 pixels. It will be placed on a conference badge and used in the list of participants
- Provide short background information about yourself (up to 300 characters)
- Accept appropriate payments if requested
- Check, accept and **submit** all data

! Please note:

- Registration is completed only upon completion of the second stage of the registration.
- The organizer will book the accommodation only for the registered participants.

2. HOW TO GET TO KRYNICA?

Arrival

8th September: the organizer offers the following transport services:

- **Transfer by buses, minibuses and cars from:** Kraków-Balice Airport and Kraków Główny railway station to Krynica. The timetable as well as transport reservation will be available through the Coded Website Information Service.
- The journey from Kraków to Krynica takes about 3 hours.

Transport can be booked by **3rd September** at the latest.

! Please note: regrettably we may not be in a position to guarantee transfer to the participants who do not provide us with their travel details by **3rd September**.

9th September: The organizer does not provide shuttle bus transfers. Each participant arriving on this day will be met at the airport or at the railway station and provided with an individual transfer to Krynica.

- **Helicopter:** It is possible to hire (at your own cost) a helicopter from Kraków-Balice airport

! Please note: The main Polish international airport in Warsaw will be partially closed beginning of September due to renovation of runways.

Transport service meeting points: How to find us?

- **Kraków-Balice Airport:** On 8th and 9th September, the transport information stand will be set at the Kraków-Balice airport, in arrival halls of both the domestic and the international terminal. It can be recognized by the **Economic Forum logo – blue apple with a green leaf overneath**. The staff will assist you to the bus/car.
- **Kraków Główny railway station:** the meeting point will be located on platform no. 5. The staff members will be holding boards **with the Economic Forum logo**.

Departure

9th, 10th, 11th September: The organizer offers the following transport services:

- **Transfer by buses, minibuses and cars:** Krynica-Kraków Balice Airport. The busses depart according to the timetable available in the Transport Booking Form. The Buses stop as follows:
 1. Balice Kraków Airport
 2. City Centre: Matejki Square, 5 min. walk from the Kraków Główny railway station.
- **Meeting point: Krynica, Main Reception**

! Please note - Participants, who booked departures early in the morning (02.00, 03.00 or 04.00 am), will be picked up directly from their hotels.

Forum BUS – transport service within Krynica

Participants accommodated out of the Krynica Centre and in Muszyna may use free of charge transport service – Forum BUS. The buses will circulate from 8th to 10th September on the appointed routes. For more information, please follow the Coded Website Information Service.

3. CODED WEBSITE INFORMATION SERVICE

Registered participants (those who completed the second stage of the registration) are strongly encouraged to follow the information given at the Coded Website.

Please, use your personal code to enter the website information service and:

- check your accommodation online,
- book transport from/to Kraków/Krynica online,
- check the profiles of all Economic Forum guests online,
- check the updated program of the Forum and the programme of the accompanying events online,
- sign up for the recreational events online.

You can login to the coded website through the Economic Forum main page: www.forum-ekonomiczne.pl. You will be asked to enter your **login** and **password**. In case you have lost it - please inform us and the password will be resend to you.

! Please note The login and the password are sent after the conference fee (if applicable) is paid.

4. ACCOMMODATION

- Upon the completion of the second stage of the registration the participants of the Economic Forum are eligible to use the accommodation provided by the organizer.
- The participants are accommodated in the hotels of varying standards in Krynica Zdroj and Muszyna (8 km from Krynica). Regardless the quality of the accommodation, the guests are accommodated one person per room.
- 1 regular booking = 3 nights + breakfast and dinner
- Check in: 2pm on 8th September
- Check out: 12am
- extension of stay: additional cost to be covered individually, requires direct reservation. Only written cancellation will be accepted. Otherwise the participant is obliged to cover the costs of the accommodation.

- **Accompanying persons:** A participant are welcome to come to the conference with a spouse, assistant or driver. The bookings for the accompanying people are made at the **additional costs:**

1 additional booking = 3 nights + 2 meals per day

The order of the applications is taken into account. Confirmation and details is sent by the organizer through email. The information is also available at the coded website.

! Please note: Due to limited number of available hotel rooms in Krynica, please register at your earliest convenience.

5. PERSONAL CONFERENCE BADGE – your electronic conference pass

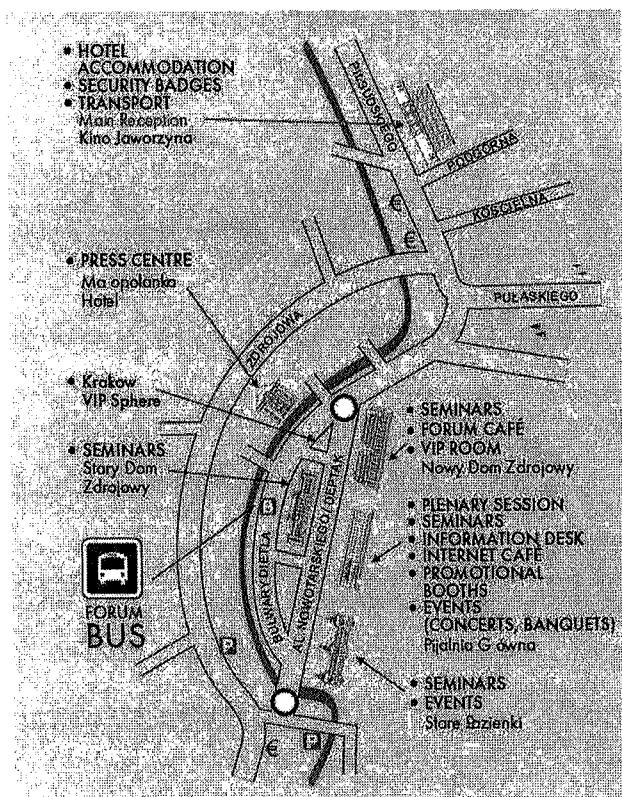
- The Forum Guests using our accommodation service will receive the conference badges at the hotel reception desk.
- The Congress Centre is subject to security services monitoring.
- The personal conference badge shall be worn during the Forum events at **all times**, as the lack of it will prevent access to seminar rooms as well as participation in the accompanying events.
- The Forum Guests as well as their **accompanying persons** may attend special events such as banquettes, concerts. Admission to some of the accompanying events, organized by the Forum partners is possible only by personal invitation.

Conference languages

Intranet stands located at the Congress Centre foster access to the Forum's intranet service. The service provides up-to-the-minute information on alterations to the Forum as well as organizational information.
