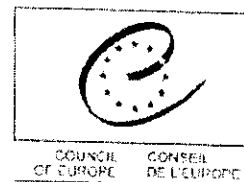
Future work: was informed by Mr Tekelioglu on the preparation of the committee meeting in Istanbul on 10 - 11 May 2010;
