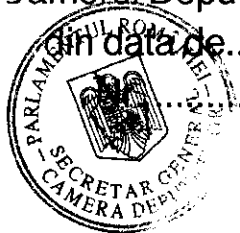

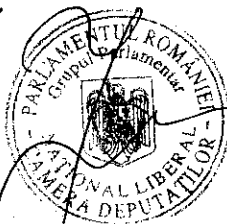

**SUBJECT: GENERALS, FLAG OFFICERS AND AMBASSADORS COURSE
2010-1 (GFOAC 2010-1), TO BE HELD FROM MONDAY 3 TO FRIDAY 7 MAY
2010.**

1. GENERAL

THE NATO DEFENSE COLLEGE IS RUNNING A HIGH LEVEL ACADEMIC COURSE DEDICATED TO FLAG OFFICERS AND HIGH RANKING CIVILIANS INCLUDING AMBASSADORS. THIS COURSE WILL TAKE PLACE AT THE NATO DEFENSE COLLEGE IN ROME, AND IS OPEN TO NATO, PARTNERSHIP FOR PEACE, MEDITERRANEAN DIALOGUE, ISTANBUL COOPERATION INITIATIVE COUNTRIES, AND TO SOME SELECTED COUNTRIES AS WELL AS SOME SELECTED INTERNATIONAL ORGANISATIONS AND NON-GOVERNMENTAL ORGANISATIONS.

THE THEME OF THE GFOAC 2010-1 WILL BE " NATO'S NEW STRATEGIC CONCEPT: CREATING A VISION FOR A SECURE FUTURE". THOSE ATTENDING WILL HAVE THE OPPORTUNITY TO EXPLORE KEY ISSUES IN AN ACADEMIC ENVIRONMENT WITH THE OPPORTUNITY FOR A FREE EXCHANGE OF IDEAS.

A MIX OF INTERNATIONALLY ACKNOWLEDGED ACADEMIC EXPERTS AND EXPERIENCED SENIOR NATO AND DIPLOMATIC PRACTICIANS WILL LECTURE ON A BROAD VARIETY OF ISSUES LIKE THE TRANSATLANTIC LINK, TERRORISM, MEDITERRANEAN DIALOGUE, AND STRATEGIC IMPLICATIONS OF NATO'S CURRENT OPERATIONS. THE COURSE WILL INCLUDE SESSIONS WITH DISCUSSIONS IN SMALLER GROUPS.

2. PARTICIPATION AND ADMINISTRATIVE REGULATIONS

THE COLLEGE WOULD LIKE TO POINT OUT THAT A SIMILAR COURSE ORGANISED IN RECENT YEARS HAS BEEN VERY SUCCESSFUL. THE COLLEGE IS THEREFORE PARTICULARLY KEEN ON CONTINUING TO ATTRACT A HIGH QUALITY MIX OF OFFICERS AND CIVILIANS, INCLUDING AMBASSADORS, COUNSELORS OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS AND HIGH RANKING CIVIL SERVANTS.

NATIONS ARE THEREFORE STRONGLY ENCOURAGED, IN ADDITION TO MINISTRIES OF DEFENSE AND FOREIGN AFFAIRS, TO NOMINATE CANDIDATES FROM OTHER AREAS WITHIN INTEREST IN THE BROADER SECURITY AGENDA. THESE AREAS COULD INCLUDE POLICE, CUSTOMS,

MINISTRIES OF JUSTICE, HOME AFFAIRS AND CIVIL EMERGENCY. IN ADDITION, THE COLLEGE WOULD WELCOME ELECTED OFFICIALS SEEKING DEEPER EXPOSURE TO SECURITY ISSUES.

NOMINEES MUST BE ONE TO THREE-STAR GENERALS OR ADMIRALS OR CIVILIAN(S) OF EQUIVALENT RANK.

3. ALLOCATION OF VACANCIES

NATIONS CAN NOMINATE NORMALLY TWO (2) PARTICIPANTS. NEVERTHELESS THE COLLEGE IS READY TO OFFER FLEXIBILITY IN THAT REGARD.

FOR LOGISTIC REASONS THE TOTAL NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS MUST NOT EXCEED 45.

IN THIS CONTEXT IS NDC AIMING AT BALANCING EQUALLY AMONGST NATO NATIONS, WHILE RESPECTING THE ACADEMIC NEEDS. IN CASE THAT THERE ARE UNFILLED VACANCIES, THESE MAY SUBSEQUENTLY BE ALLOCATED TO OTHER NATIONS. THEREFORE ADDRESSEES MAY WISH TO APPLY FOR MORE VACANCIES THAN INDICATED ABOVE.

4. ACTION DATES (NOT LATER THAN)

FRIDAY 26 FEBRUARY 2010

NATIONS ARE REQUESTED TO SEND THEIR NOMINATIONS TO THE NATO DEFENSE COLLEGE (NDC) BY E-MAIL OR FAX, WITH INFORMATION ABOUT THE NAMES, RANKS, SERVICES, MAILING ADDRESSES, TEL AND FAX NUMBERS AND E-MAIL OF THEIR PARTICIPANTS.

DUE TO PLANNING AND LOGISTICAL REASONS THIS DATE IS BINDING, NO NOMINATIONS FOR THE COURSE CAN BE ACCEPTED AFTER THIS DAY. AFTER THIS DATE FREE SLOTS NOT REQUESTED BY NATIONS, WILL BE GIVEN TO THOSE NATIONS WHO HAVE ASKED FOR ADDITIONAL PLACES.

ALL EMAIL SHOULD HAVE THE NAME "GFOAC" IN ITS SUBJECT.

FRIDAY 19 MARCH 2010

JOINING QUESTIONNAIRE AND SPECIFIC INFORMATION WILL BE SENT DIRECTLY TO THE PARTICIPANTS.

FRIDAY 26 MARCH 2010

JOINING REPLIES MUST BE RECEIVED AT THE COLLEGE

ALL EMAIL SHOULD HAVE THE NAME "GFOAC" IN ITS SUBJECT.

5. LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

THE WORKING LANGUAGE THROUGHOUT THE COURSE WILL BE ENGLISH. HOWEVER, ALL PLENARY LECTURES ARE SIMULTANEOUSLY TRANSLATED INTO FRENCH.

6. SECURITY CLASSIFICATION

DOCUMENTS, BRIEFINGS AND PRESENTATIONS WILL HAVE NO CLASSIFICATION.

7. VISAS, COSTS AND TRANSPORT

PARTICIPANTS WILL HAVE TO MOVE WITHIN SCHENGEN AREA: ACCORDING TO THEIR CITIZENSHIP, THEIR PASSPORTS MAY BE PROVIDED WITH A MULTIPLE-ENTRY SCHENGEN VISA FOR THE DURATION OF THE COURSE, IF APPROPRIATE.

TRAVEL, HOTEL AND PER DIEM COSTS DURING THE STAY WILL BE AT THE SENDING NATIONS' EXPENSES.

FOR THE BUDGETARY PLANNING THE FOLLOWING COSTS SHOULD BE TAKEN INTO ACCOUNT:

A) TRANSPORTATION TO AND FROM ROME

B) ACCOMODATION IN ROME: HOTELS HAVE BEEN PRE-BOOKED. COST IS APPROXIMATELY 180 EUROS PER DAY FOR A SINGLE ROOM OR 200 EUROS FOR A DOUBLE ROOM (BREAKFAST INCLUDED);

C) SELF SERVICE LUNCHEES IN THE COLLEGE MESS COST APPROXIMATELY 10 EUROS PER DAY

D) NORMAL MEALS AND DINNERS IN ROMAN RESTAURANTS COST APPROXIMATELY 30 EUROS EACH.

E) A COURSE FEE OF APPROXIMATELY 60 EUROS IS CHARGED TO COVER FORMAL LUNCHEES AND COFFEE BREAKS DURING THE PERIOD.

8. MEDICAL SUPPORT

IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE COURSE MEMBER TO HAVE MEDICAL COVERAGE FOR THE ENTIRE DURATION OF THE COURSE. THE HOST NATION PROVIDES ONLY A FIRST AID FACILITY. THEREFORE, FOR ANY OTHER MEDICAL PROBLEM BUT FIRST AID, COURSE MEMBERS MUST REFER TO THE ITALIAN MEDICAL SYSTEM IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE BILATERAL AGREEMENT SUBSCRIBED BY THEIR COUNTRY WITH THE HOST NATION.
