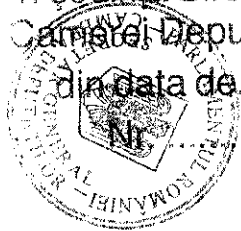

În contextul "Săptămânii Europene privind Energia Durabilă", Comisia Europeană va organiza la Bruxelles, la 23 martie a.c., reuniunea cu tema „Din Bruxelles către orașele noastre: Planul de Acțiune la toate nivelele – Care sinergii sunt posibile?”

Propunem:

- deplasarea să se efectueze cu avionul, pe ruta București-Bruxelles și retur, cu plecare în ziua de 23 martie a.c., ora 7.20, zbor SN 4032 și întoarcere în ziua de 24 martie a.c., orele 14.00, zbor SN 4031;
- să se acorde drepturi de diurnă categoria a II-a, 100% pentru 1 1/2 zile, cazare plafon B pentru 1 noapte, precum și un avans de 50% cu decontare ulterioară;
- recalcularea cheltuielilor să se efectueze la întoarcerea în țară pe baza documentelor justificative.
