**Tema: Cea de-a treia Conferință Mondială a Președinților de Parlamente
(Geneva, 19 – 21 iulie 2010)**

Uniunea Interparlamentară (UIP) organizează la Geneva, în perioada 19 – 21 iulie 2010, cea de-a treia Conferință Mondială a Președinților de Parlamente.

Conferința se va desfășura la sediul ONU din Geneva și va avea ca temă generală „Parlamentele într-o lume a crizei: garantarea responsabilității democratice mondiale pentru binele comun”. Dezbaterile se vor încheia cu adoptarea unui document final pe tema menționată.

Scopul urmărit de organizatori este de a promova democrația la nivel internațional prin implicarea într-o mai mare măsură a parlamentarilor în problematica internațională și de a consolida legăturile dintre parlamente și Organizația Națiunilor Unite.

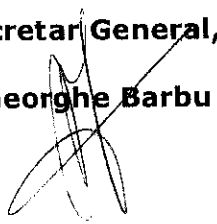

Acțiunea are caracter parlamentar conform art. 3, lit. d) din HBP 1/2003 modificată și completată prin HBP 5/2007.

Propunem:

- să se aprobe participarea doamnei Roberta Alma Anastase, președinta Camerei Deputaților și a domnului Ionuț Lăcustă, consilier în cadrul Cancelariei președintei Camerei Deputaților la conferința menționată;
- deplasarea să se efectueze cu avionul, pe ruta București – Munchen – Geneva – Frankfurt – București, cu plecare în data de 18 iulie 2010, ora 16:50 (LH 3423) și întoarcere în data de 22 iulie 2010, ora 17:25 (LH 3414);
- să se acorde drepturi de diurnă categoria a II-a, 100%, pentru 4 zile, cazare plafon B, pentru 4 nopți, și un avans de 50% cu decontare ulterioară;
- să se aprobe suportarea din bugetul Camerei Deputaților a contravalorii cadourilor simbolice pentru delegația condusă de președinta Camerei Deputaților, în conformitate cu art. 57, alin. 1, lit. a) din HBP 1/2003 modificată și completată prin HBP 5/2007;
- eventualele cheltuieli de protocol să se suporte din avansul cu decontare ulterioară;
- recalcularea cheltuielilor se va face la întoarcerea în țară, pe baza documentelor justificative.

Dear Madam President,

I trust that you will shortly be announcing your participation in the 3rd World Conference of Speakers of Parliament and that you will be joining your colleagues from around the world for this unique event.

I now attach the draft agenda and programme of work for the Conference. I also enclose a Note which provides the latest information regarding the event and the different activities - panel discussions, lunch time events and receptions - which are being organized for your benefit.

I wish to draw your particular attention to the fact that the group photo of the Speakers of Parliament will now be taken at 12.30 pm on 19 July. It will be followed by a lunch that I am offering in honour of the Speakers and which I very much hope that you will wish to attend.

I enclose a copy of the draft declaration which will be presented to the Conference for adoption at the end of your deliberations. The draft declaration incorporates many of the proposals that parliaments submitted to the earlier version which I had circulated for comments. I draw your attention to the fact that both the Rules and the draft declaration are being translated into the six official languages of the United Nations – Arabic, Chinese, English, French, Russian and Spanish – and will be placed on the IPU Website - www.ipu.org – as soon as they are available.

I very much hope to be able to welcome you in Geneva and to hear your views on parliaments' role in securing global democratic accountability for the common good.
