Propunem:

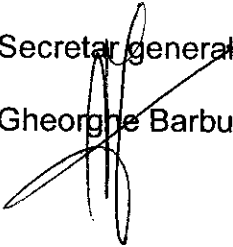
- să se aprobe participarea domnului deputat Doru Frunzuliță la acest seminar;

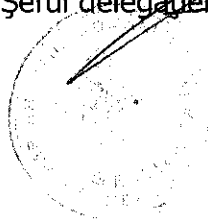

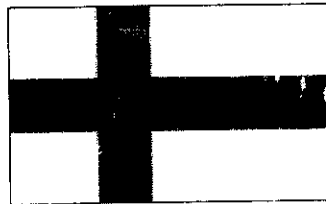
