În perioada 31 mai - 2 iunie 2010, la Barcelona, Spania va avea loc reuniunea Comisiei internaționale pentru redactarea Proiectului Declarației Universale privind “Drepturile Omului la pace”, organizată de Societatea spaniolă de Drept Internațional privind Drepturile Omului în colaborare cu Centrul UNESCO pentru regiunea Bască, precum și cu Institutul internațional catalan pentru pace.

Dear H. E. Mr. Adrian Nastase

We have the pleasure of inform you that, in the context of the international campaign on the human right to peace conducted since 2007 by the Spanish Society for International Human Rights Law (SSIHRL) in collaboration with the UNESCO Centre for the Basque Country, our Organisations (the SSIHRL and the International Catalan Institute for Peace, ICIP) are convening the *International Drafting Committee on the draft universal declaration of the human right to peace*. The meeting will be held at the Parliament of Catalonia, Barcelona, Spain on 31 May-2 June 2010, with the sponsorship of the Spanish Agency for International Cooperation to Development and the support of the Parliament of Catalonia.

The International Drafting Committee will be composed of ten international experts, two from each of the five geographical groups represented at the United Nations, namely Group of Latin American and Caribbean Region, African Group, Asian Group, Group of Western European and Other States, and Eastern European Group. The experts shall be selected taking into consideration their competence and experience in the field of human rights, particularly the human right to peace, their moral integrity, independence, and gender balance.

The International Drafting Committee shall meet during three working days to review and finalize the draft universal declaration on the human right to peace. To facilitate its work, the Committee will be provided with a draft declaration adopted in Bilbao on 24 February 2010 by the Preparatory Technical Committee. The final text of universal declaration on the human right to peace, as expected to be adopted on 2nd June 2010 by the International Drafting Committee, will be submitted to the consideration of the *NGO International Congress on the Human Right to Peace* to be held in Santiago de Compostela, Spain on 9-10 December 2010 at the occasion of the World Social Forum on Education for Peace ("Forum 2010").

The International Congress shall finalize the civil society's codification of the human right to peace. The end product will then be submitted to the UN Human Rights Council, urging Member States to initiate the official codification of the human right to peace.

Taking into account your personal experience and commitment with the human right to peace and its international codification and progressive development within the United Nations competent bodies, we are honoured to invite you to participate as an expert at the International Drafting Committee.

Should you accept this invitation, you will be provided with a round-trip air ticket from your country to Barcelona. Hotel accommodation and meals shall also be provided to you free of charge, as well as a per diem. The meeting will also be provided with simultaneous interpretation into four languages (English, French, Spanish and Catalan).
