MEMORANDUM INTERN

Tema: Participarea la Forumul parlamentar transatlantic (Washington, 6-7 decembrie 2010)

Adunarea parlamentară a NATO, în cooperare cu Consiliul Atlantic al SUA și Universitatea Națională de Apărare, organizează la Washington, în perioada 6-7 decembrie, tradiționalul Forum parlamentar transatlantic.

Forumul, care este consacrat examinării unei largi game de probleme de securitate, va avea următoarele teme de dezbatere : 1. Relațiile SUA-Europa și Agenda globală ; 2. Evaluarea summitului NATO de la Lisabona ; 3. SUA și agenda internațională privind controlul armamentelor ; 4. Situația din Afganistan ; 5. Securitatea în Orientul Mijlociu : Relațiile SUA cu Israelul, lumea arabă și Iranul ; 6. Relațiile SUA-Rusia : Așteptări și limitări ; 7. Cheltuielile pentru apărare ale SUA : Echilibrul între resurse și angajamentele globale.

La acest forum iau parte membrii delegațiilor naționale la AP NATO. Din partea Camerei Deputaților urmează să participe domnii deputați Sever Voinescu-Cotoi, membru al Biroului permanent al Camerei Deputaților și șef al delegației, și George Scutaru, membru al delegației.

Acțiunea are caracter parlamentar, conform Art. 3 alin. a) al HBP 1/2003, modificată și completată prin HBP 5/2007.

Propunem:

- să se aprobe participarea domnilor deputați Sever Voinescu-Cotoi și George Scutaru;

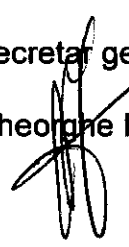
- deplasarea să se facă pe ruta București-Paris-Washington și retur, cu plecare în ziua de 5 decembrie, ora 13.00 (AF 288) și întoarcere în ziua de 9 decembrie, ora 16.15 (AF 2788);

- să se acorde cazare pentru 3 nopți la hotelul recomandat de organizatori, diurnă categoria a II-a 100% pentru 4 ½ zile, precum și un avans cu decontare ulterioară de 50%; în cazul în care se percepe o taxă de participare și/sau acoperirea costului transportului intern, acestea să fie suportate din avansul cu decontare ulterioară;

- recalcularea drepturilor se va face la întoarcere, pe baza documentelor justificative.
