În perioada 30 septembrie - 1 octombrie 2010, Senatul belgian organizează, la Bruxelles, cea de a șasea ediție a Conferinței comisiilor parlamentare pentru supravegherea serviciilor de informații din statele membre ale Uniunii Europene.

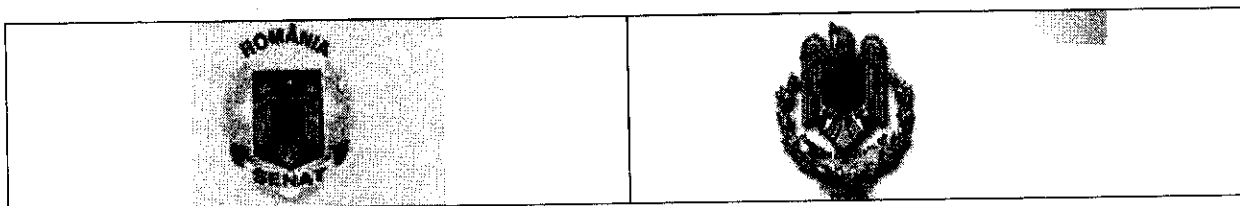
Propunem:

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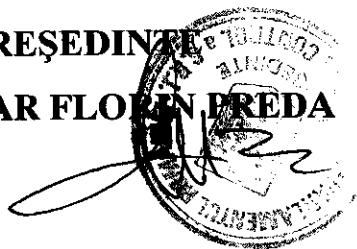

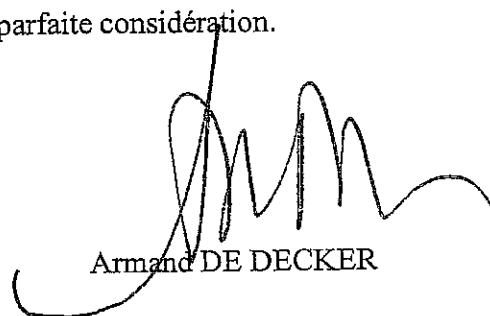

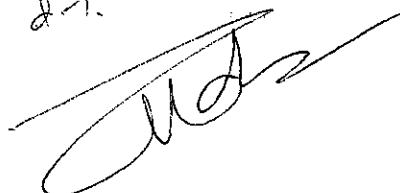
