**Tema: Participarea la reuniunea Comisiei pentru probleme economice și dezvoltare a APCE, la cea de a treia parte a Sesiunii ordinare 2011 a APCE și la acțiunile premurgătoare, precum și la Sesiunea Forumului Crans Montana (Paris, Strasbourg și Bruxelles, 17 – 25 iunie 2011)**

În perioada 17 – 20 iunie 2011 se vor desfășura la Paris și Strasbourg lucrările Comisiei pentru probleme economice și dezvoltare, ale Comitetului președinților și ale conducerii grupurilor politice din cadrul Adunării Parlamentare a Consiliului Europei (APCE), iar în perioada 20 – 24 iunie 2011, va avea loc la Strasbourg cea de a treia parte a Sesiunii ordinare 2011 a Adunării Parlamentare a Consiliului Europei.

În perioada 22 – 25 iunie 2011, la Bruxelles, se va desfășura Sesiunea Forumului Crans Montana la care urmează să participe domnul deputat Adrian Năstase, vicepreședinte al Camerei Deputaților. Totodată, domnul deputat Adrian Năstase a comunicat stabilirea unor întâlniri, premurgătoare Sesiunii APCE, cu omologi din legislativul francez, la Paris.

La aceste acțiuni urmează să participe membrii Delegației Parlamentului României la APCE, precum și secretariatul acesteia, conform repartizării lor în structurile APCE și programul acestora, respectiv domnii deputați **Cezar Preda** (PD-L), șeful Delegației, Președintele Comisiei comune a Camerei Deputaților și Senatului pentru exercitarea controlului parlamentar asupra activității SRI, **Adrian Năstase** (PSD), vicepreședinte al Camerei Deputaților, **Relu Fenechiu** (PNL), Președintele Comisiei pentru tehnologia informației și comunicațiilor, **Mihai Tudose** (PSD), Președintele Comisiei pentru politică economică, reformă și privatizare, **Florin Anghel** (PD-L), doamna deputată **Maria Stavrositu** (PD-L), parlamentar de referință al legislativului român în Campania Consiliului Europei pentru combaterea violenței împotriva femeilor, precum și doamnele Nadia Ionescu, director, secretara Delegației Parlamentului României la APCE, și Alina Ilie, funcționar parlamentar în cadrul secretariatului Delegației.

Pe agenda Sesiunii APCE, de la Strasbourg, figurează audierea unor declarații și prezentări susținute de personalități ale vieții politice internaționale, precum și adoptarea unor rapoarte ale comisiilor de specialitate, iar în cadrul Forumului Crans Montana, de la Bruxelles, vor avea loc dezbateri pe teme privind Uniunea Europeană și criza economică mondială, Securitatea energetică europeană, Resursele naturale: cheia pentru dezvoltare dar și pentru o bună alimentație, Cooperarea sud-sud: un nou cadru pentru Europa și Africa, etc.

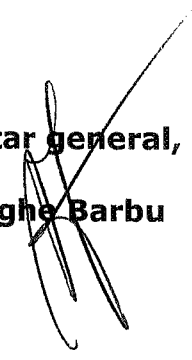
