Acțiunea are caracter parlamentar conform art.3, lit. c) din HBP 1/2003 cu modificările și completările din HBP 5/2007.

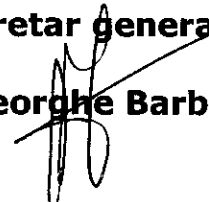
Propunem:

- să se acorde drepturi de diurnă categoria a II-a, după cum urmează: 70% pentru 1 zi și 100% pentru 1 ½ zile, cazare plafon B pentru 2 nopți, la hotelul recomandat de către organizatori, precum și un avans de 50% cu decontare ulterioară;

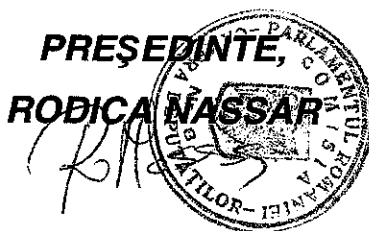

Dear Visitor,

By organizing the Conference of the Chairs of the Committees on Health Affairs of Parliaments of the European Union, we would like to establish a tradition. We are hopeful that health policy can also play an active role during Hungary's EU Presidency in 2011.

Since the Treaty of Lisbon came into force, the role of national parliaments has been changing, with the involvement and cooperation of committees being one of the decisive changes. It is a well known fact that while economic development determines the health status of a population, the health status of the people also has a impact on the economy. Thus, we believe that our joint efforts on the level of parliamentary committees to abolish the health inequalities in the European Union may contribute to enhancing the competitiveness of member states. This is particularly important in Central Europe, where the population's health status – according to the EU indicators – is significantly worse than the EU average. In the long term, this may endanger the EU's harmonious and balanced development. With a view to the 2006 Declaration on the Common Principles and Values of the European Union Health Systems and the European Health Strategy 2008 - 2013, we can no longer put off concrete action. The time has come to devote efforts - harder than ever before - to encourage the steps intended to improve the health status of EU citizens.

We hope that the Conference of the Chairs of Committees on Health Affairs will provide an opportunity for EU member states to think together, and that it will help us find the solutions to our public health problems. Thus, we can lay the foundations necessary to help EU citizens in every member state to enjoy the best possible level of health.

The most important problems to be solved are as follows.

- existing social and economic inequalities create dramatic health inequalities in the populations of the region, with special emphasis on the Roma population, representing more than 10 percent of the inhabitants in some countries;

- a serious social burden ensuing from chronic, non-contagious diseases and the related mortality, as well as a critical health behaviour;
- a lack of health status/disease monitoring, impeding targeted health policy decisions and public health interventions;
- the almost complete lack of health impact studies which makes impact estimations of interventions (to intensify positive effects and eliminate or mitigate negative effects) almost impossible, and thus torpedo the success of the "Health in all policy" principle drafted by the Finnish EU Presidency;
- deficiencies in the management of public health programmes, primarily manifested in the absence of inter-sectoral practice, there is no targeted and coordinated strategy, there is no common practice of drafting and implementing action and training programmes in the field of health promotion and prevention.



The aim of the conference is to design an evidence-based strategy, make recommendations and propose actions with Hungary's leadership to tackle the EU's common public health problems. We hope that these interventions will help the relevant countries in catching up with their counterparts already in the medium term. By reducing health inequalities, such a development would contribute to the stability and harmonious development of an expanding European Union.

The Conference of the Chairs of the Committees on Health Affairs - to be held on 14-15 April 2011 - will offer a good opportunity to chairpersons to explain the opinion of their parliaments and their citizens in the above mentioned questions.

I trust that the contributions made at the conference will help the everyday work of EU policymakers, and that by adopting new attitudes and establishing new consultation forums we may help our citizens change their values and we can all move towards a "Healthy Europe".
