**Tema: Participarea la prima parte a Sesiunii ordinare 2011 a Adunării
Parlamentare a Consiliului Europei - APCE (24-28 ianuarie 2011)**

În perioada 24-28 ianuarie 2011, la Strasbourg, se va desfășura prima parte a Sesiunii ordinare 2011 a Adunării Parlamentare a Consiliului Europei (APCE), prilej cu care se va reuni Subcomisia pentru numirea judecătorilor la Curtea Europeană a Drepturilor Omului a Comisiei juridice și pentru drepturile omului a APCE, din care face parte domnul deputat **Tudor Panțiru** (Alianța PSD+PC), membru al Delegației Parlamentului României la APCE, Președintele Subcomisiei pentru monitorizarea hotărârilor Curții Europene a Drepturilor Omului din cadrul Comisiei juridice, de disciplină și imunități a Camerei Deputaților.

Acțiunea are caracter parlamentar conform art. 3, litera a) din HBP nr. 1/2003 cu modificările și completările din HBP nr. 5/2007.

Propunem:

- să se aprobe participarea domnului deputat Tudor Panțiru la acțiunea menționată mai sus;
- deplasarea domnului deputat Tudor Panțiru să se facă cu avionul pe ruta București-Strasbourg și retur, plecare în data de 25 ianuarie 2011, ora 13.00 (AF 2889) și întoarcere în data de 29 ianuarie 2011, ora 19.15 (AF 2488);
- să se acorde drepturi de diurnă categoria a II-a pentru 4 ½ zile, cazare plafon B pentru 4 nopți, în numerar, întrucât rezervările se efectuează prin intermediul Reprezentanței Permanente a României la Consiliul Europei și un avans de 50% cu decontare ulterioară;
- recalcularea cheltuielilor să se facă la întoarcerea în țară, pe baza documentelor justificative.

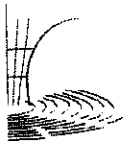
