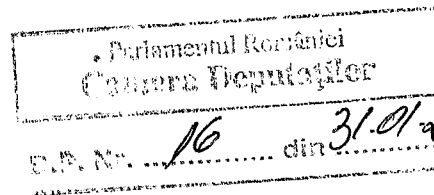

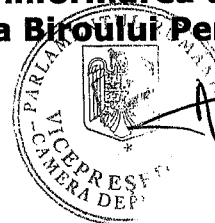

MEMORANDUM INTERN

**Tema: Participarea la „Cea de a doua Conferință politică” a Organizației
Prietenii Europeni ai Israelului (Ierusalim, 4-8 februarie 2011)**

Organizația Europeană de promovare a democrației, păcii și dialogului, „Prietenii Europeni ai Israelului” (PEI), ai cărei membri sunt parlamentari atât din cadrul Parlamentului European cât și din cadrul parlamentelor naționale din întreaga Europă, va organiza „Cea de a doua Conferință politică”, care se va desfășura la Ierusalim, în perioada 4-8 februarie 2011.

La această acțiune urmează să participe, la invitația domnului Gunnar Hokmark, președintele PEI, vice-președinte al Grupului parlamentar al Partidului Popular European din cadrul Parlamentului European, domnii deputați **Olosz Gergely**, liderul Grupului parlamentar al Uniunii Democratice Maghiare din România, **Aurel Vainer**, (Grupul parlamentar al minorităților naționale), președintele Federației Comunităților Evreiești din România, **Ibraim Iuseim** (Grupul parlamentar al minorităților naționale), și **Dorel Covaci** (PSD), domnul Gheorghe Barbu, Secretar general al Camerei Deputaților precum și domnului Mircea Șovagău, expert parlamentar în cadrul Direcției pentru cooperare parlamentară internațională multilaterală.

Prin memorandumul intern nr. 55a/2433 din 27 decembrie 2010 s-a aprobat participarea domnului deputat Dorel Covaci la cea de-a 59-a reuniune a „Micului dejun național cu rugăciune”, care va avea loc la Washington D.C. în 3 februarie 2011. Datorită programului celor două acțiuni, domnul deputat Dorel Covaci urmează să efectueze deplasarea la Tel Aviv pe ruta Washington – Tel Aviv. **Organizatorii au comunicat că suportă cheltuielile pentru transportul internațional pentru participanții care efectuează deplasarea în Israel cu plecare din București, cazarea și mesele pentru toți participanții, pentru toată perioada acțiunii.**

Acțiunea are caracter parlamentar conform art. 3, alin e, al HBP 1/2003 modificată și completată prin HBP 5/2007.

Propunem:

- să se aprobe participarea delegației la această acțiune;
- să se suporte din bugetul Camerei Deputaților contravaloarea biletului de avion al domnului deputat Dorel Covaci pe ruta București – Washington – Tel Aviv - București; prevederile memorandumului intern nr. 55a/2433 din 27 decembrie 2010 privind transportul domnului deputat Dorel Covaci, se modifică în mod corespunzător conform noului traseu anexat precum și cele privind diurna acordată pe relația SUA (2 ½ zile);
- pentru restul delegației deplasarea să se facă cu avionul pe ruta București – Tel Aviv și retur cu plecare din București în 4 februarie 2011 și întoarcere în 8 februarie 2011;
- pentru domnul deputat Dorel Covaci, să se acorde drepturi de diurnă categoria a II-a, 50% pentru 3 ½ zile, și un avans de 50% cu decontare ulterioară;
- pentru restul delegației să se acorde drepturi de diurnă categoria a II-a, 50% pentru 4 ½ zile, și un avans de 50% cu decontare ulterioară;
- să se suporte din bugetul Camerei Deputaților contravaloarea cadourilor simbolice conform art. 57, alin. 2, lit. b al HBP 1/2003 modificată și completată prin HBP 5/2007;
- recalcularea cheltuielilor să se facă la întoarcerea în țară pe baza documentelor justificative.
