În perioada 24 - 25 februarie a.c., la Budapesta, va avea loc reuniunea comună a președinților Comisiilor pentru finanțe din parlamentele statelor membre ale Uniunii Europene, organizată de Adunarea Națională a Republicii Ungare, în contextul deținerii președinției UE de către această țară în primul semestru al anului 2011.

Pe agenda reuniunii se află în dezbatere probleme legate de revizuirea bugetului și dezvoltarea unei noi perspective financiare, strategiile de management al crizei, sisteme de supraveghere fiscală și reînnoirea mecanismelor de stabilitate. Reuniunea se bucură de intervenții din partea unor reprezentanți ai Comisiei Europene, ai executivului maghiar și ai mediului academic.

Menționez că organizatorii asigură o masă pentru toți participanții în ziua de 25 februarie 2011.

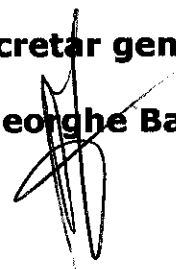
Acțiunea se încadrează la art. 3, alin. c. al HBP 1/2003, modificată și completată prin HBP 5/2007.

Propunem:

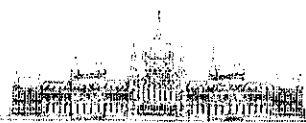
- să se aprobe participarea domnului deputat Adrian Nițu la acțiunea menționată;

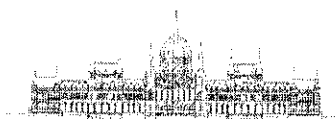
