Precizăm că partea iraniană asigură cazarea și mesele zilnice pentru participanții la acest eveniment.

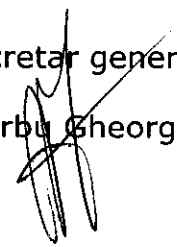
Acțiunea se încadrează în prevederile art. 3, alin.e, din HBP 1/2003 completată și modificată prin HBP 5/2007.

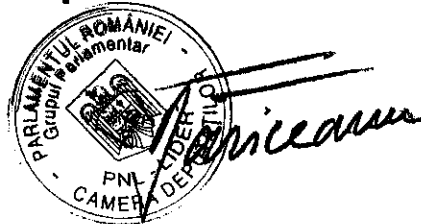

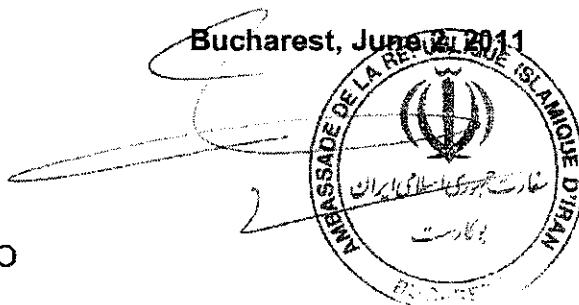

3rd Meeting of the Executive Bureau of FASPPED
18 June 2011, Tehran, IR of Iran

Introduction

Education for All is the cornerstone of sustainable human development and is a key means to achieve the MDGs, in particular the overarching goal of halving poverty by 2015 and the objectives of the two education-related MDGs. Education empowers people with the knowledge, skills and confidence required to shape a better future. Development and economic prosperity depend on the ability of countries to educate all members of their societies and offer them lifelong learning.

Bearing on the particular issues and challenges to which the Asia and the Pacific region has been subject for achieving the EFA goals, the MDGs and international priorities as referred to in programmes of the various decades and international action plans¹, including the fact that 5 of the world's highest population countries from the total of 9 high-population countries that are home to more than two thirds of the world's adult illiterates and 40% of out-of-school children are located in the Asia and the Pacific, altogether calling for a thorough mobilisation of political will power, harmonization of efforts of all stakeholders in education, including development partners, Governments, NGOs, civil society and international agencies, particularly UNESCO.

In this trend, Parliaments and parliamentarians play an essential role in influencing their governments to comply with international instruments through the Forum of the Asia-Pacific Parliamentarians for Education (FASPPED). FASPPED has been established in the Asia-Pacific region in cooperation with UNESCO. The FASPPED secretariat is located in UNESCO and works to promote internationally agreed upon priorities in education, in cooperation with its member states. FASPPED's mission statement and defined modalities of action altogether call for the organisation of meetings of the Forum's Executive Board in an attempt to further consider and reflect on ways to accelerate achievement of educational objectives in their optimum, in the region.

In view of the above, the IR of Iran, newly elected President of the Forum of Asia-Pacific Parliamentarians for Education (FASPPED), will do its utmost to contribute to the advancement of the Forum's cause and to achieve its objectives, in which regards Tehran has sought to host the 3rd session of the FASPPED Executive Bureau in cooperation with UNESCO.

3. Reflecting on additional programmes and activities proposed by the IR of Iran and Members to the Executive Bureau of FASPPED (Indonesia, Bangladesh, Samoa, South Korea, Vietnam);
4. Reinforcing ties and strengthening cooperation among members to the FASPPED Executive Bureau in all levels;
5. Sharing experiences and best practices on FASPPED activities in the Asia and the Pacific;
6. Decision-making about issues of high organizational importance.

Draft Concept Paper

Regional Workshop on the Role of Education in Meeting Challenges of the Contemporary World: Quality Education, a Key Instrument in the Recognition of Sustainable Development Goals 19 June 2011 Tehran, Islamic Parliament of Iran

Access to Quality Education for all and life-long learning is an important measure in the establishment of knowledge societies. Improving the quality of education in all its aspects, a 6th goal of the Dakar Framework for Action, emphasises the assessment of learning outcomes and processes. An effective assessment thus calls for the identification of challenges, development of capacities, improvement of national and regional planning processes and the strengthening of evaluation and monitoring mechanisms.

With a view to the fact that the quality of education is an important issue of the Asia and the Pacific region, which has created a wide gap between countries of the Region, within the framework of and back-to-back with the 3rd Session of the FASPPED Executive Bureau Meeting, the Education Department of the Iranian National Commission for UNESCO is going to organise jointly with the Islamic Parliament of Iran, a regional workshop on, “*The Role of Education in Meeting Challenges of the Contemporary World: Quality Education, a Key Instrument in the Recognition of Sustainable Development Goals*”, on 19 June 2011 at the Islamic Parliament of Iran.

Workshop Objectives:

- Depicting the place and role of Quality Education in achieving the goals of EFA, ESD and the MDGs;
- Proposing guidelines for strengthening of the various aspects of Quality Education in the countries of the Asia and the Pacific region;
- Helping to reinforce required mechanisms necessary for reducing the educational gap between countries of the Region from a qualitative point of view.

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Workshop Themes:

- The future-oriented role of Quality Education in the process of Sustainable Development;
