Stimați colegi,

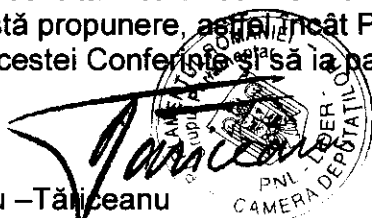

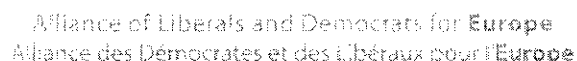

Dear colleague,

Within the next few weeks the European Commission will propose a new multi-annual financial framework of the European Union for the period 2014-2020.

The Treaty sets out that the European Commission must first make a proposal. This proposal should then be discussed by the Council, but no decision can be made without the consent of the European Parliament.

Currently, the general approach seems to be that neither the National Parliaments nor the European Parliament are really involved in the debate, even though this concerns the Union's resources which is primarily a discussion that should be undertaken by elected Members of Parliament, be they national or European. It is, I think, necessary that in this very important matter the voice of all our parliaments are heard.

In order to address this issue, the Alliance of Liberals and Democrats for Europe propose to organise, before the Council takes its decision, "a Conference on the future Financing of the European Union". In this conference the National Parliaments and the European Parliament must discuss with the European Commission and the Council the future financing of the Union for the period 2014-2020.

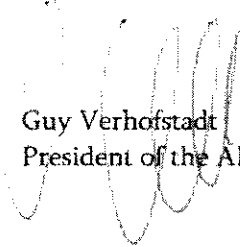
More concretely, the conference should have the opportunity to discuss the amount and priorities of the European budget, the size of the CAP, the own resources, and the future of the rebates.

In my opinion the holding of such a conference with the involvement of Parliaments would greatly increase the democratic legitimacy of the Union, which is one of the main ambitions for Liberals and Democrats. I would therefore like to invite you to support this proposal. It would be excellent if you or a Member of your parliamentary group could launch this idea in your own country.

Finally, I also want to let you know that I have sent this proposal to the future Polish Presidency who will be charged with convening it - and they have reacted very positively.

I would like to thank you in advance for following this up.
