Anexez prezentei invitația de participare la acest eveniment și menționez că nu solicit cheltuieli de transport, cazare sau diurnă.

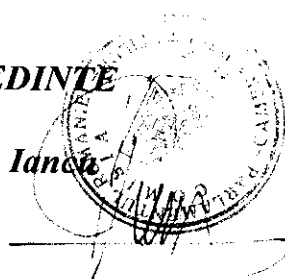
