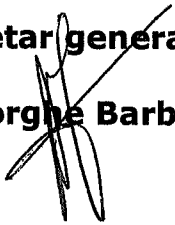

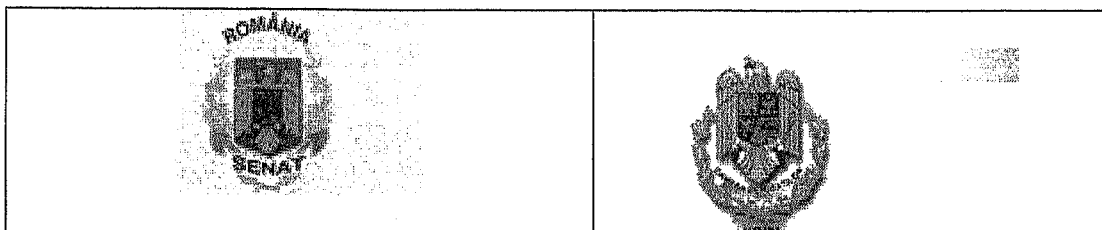
Propunem:

- recalcularea cheltuielilor să se facă la întoarcerea în țară, pe baza documentelor justificative.
