MEMORANDUM INTERN

Tema: Participarea la audierea privind situația implementării deciziilor CEDO în România și la lucrările Subcomisiei pentru alegerea judecătorilor la Curtea Europeană a Drepturilor Omului a Adunării Parlamentare a Consiliului Europei (Strasbourg, 25 – 29 iunie 2012)

În cadrul celei de-a treia părți a Sesiunii ordinare 2012 a Adunării Parlamentare a Consiliului Europei (APCE) de la Strasbourg, vor avea loc audierea privind situația implementării deciziilor CEDO în România și lucrările Subcomisiei pentru alegerea judecătorilor la Curtea Europeană a Drepturilor Omului, în perioada 25 – 29 iunie 2012, la care urmează să participe domnul deputat **Tudor Panțiru** (PSD), membru al Delegației Parlamentului României la APCE și membru al Subcomisiei APCE.

Acțiunea are caracter parlamentar conform art. 3, litera a) din HBP nr. 1/2003 cu modificările și completările din HBP nr. 5/2007.

Propunem:

- să se aprobe participarea domnului deputat Tudor Panțiru la această acțiune;
- deplasarea să se efectueze cu avionul pe ruta București – Strasbourg și retur, cu plecare în data de 24.06.2012, ora 15.15 (OK 803) și întoarcere în data de 29.06.2012, ora 14.30 (OK 802), conform traseului anexat;
- să se acorde drepturi de diurnă categoria a II-a, 100 %, pentru 5 zile, cazare plafon B în numerar, pentru 5 nopți, întrucât rezervarea cazării se face prin intermediul Reprezentanței permanente a României pe lângă Consiliul Europei de la Strasbourg, precum și un avans de 50% cu decontare ulterioară;
- recalcularea cheltuielilor să se facă la întoarcerea în țară, pe baza documentelor justificative.

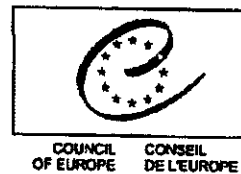

Monsieur le Président,

La commission des questions juridiques et des droits de l'homme a décidé, à sa réunion du 26 avril 2012, de continuer sa série d'auditions au sein de la commission pendant la partie de session de juin 2012 de l'Assemblée, à Strasbourg, pour examiner avec les chefs des délégations parlementaires concernées les mesures à prendre pour mettre en œuvre les arrêts de la Cour européenne des droits de l'homme au niveau national.

Je vous invite, par conséquent, à une réunion de la commission le **mardi 26 juin 2012 de 14h45 à 15h30 (salle de réunion 10, à confirmer, Palais de l'Europe)**. Etant donné que les questions qui seront soulevées seront probablement de nature technique, vous pouvez venir accompagné, si vous le souhaitez, d'un représentant du Gouvernement (comme un agent de l'Etat qui défend vos autorités devant la Cour). Lors de l'audition, vous serez invité à présenter les mesures concrètes adoptées par vos autorités, dont les initiatives prises par votre parlement, pour résoudre les problèmes recensés dans la Résolution 1787 (2011) de l'Assemblée, paragraphes 3 et ceux qui sont mis en évidence au paragraphe 7.6 (notamment les problèmes soulevés dans l'arrêt pilote *Maria Atanasiu et autres* de la Cour du 12 octobre 2010, la durée excessive de procédures judiciaires, l'inexécution de décisions de justice définitives et la mise en œuvre de l'arrêt *Rotaru*).

S'agissant de la demande d'informations précises sur les questions soulevées dans la Résolution 1787 (2011) adressée par le Président de l'Assemblée, la réponse reçue à ce jour (le 23 janvier 2012) n'aborde apparemment pas tous les problèmes importants mis en lumière dans la jurisprudence de la Cour de Strasbourg, notamment la question des mauvaises conditions de détention (voir § 104 du rapport de M. Christos Pourgourides sur la mise en œuvre des arrêts de la Cour ; doc. 12455 du 20 décembre 2010). En outre, des précisions sur le calendrier et l'état des travaux (y inclus législatifs) concernant la mise en œuvre des arrêts *Maria Atanasiu et autres* et *Rotaru* seraient utiles.

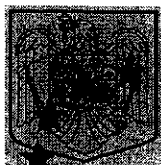
Je vous saurais gré de bien vouloir soumettre tout document d'information utile en rapport avec votre intervention d'ici le 7 juin 2012.

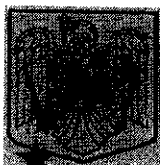
