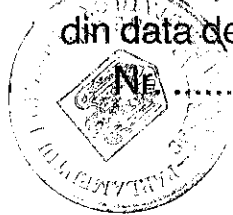

În perioada 15-16 aprilie 2013, la Skopje, la sediul Parlamentului Republicii Macedonia, vor avea loc două acțiuni conjugate, sub egida Președinției în exercițiu macedonene a Procesului de Cooperare din Europa de Sud-Est (SEECp), astfel:

- ce-a de-a noua reuniune a Grupului de lucru privind instituționalizarea dimensiunii parlamentare a SEECp (16 aprilie 2013) în organizarea Parlamentului Republicii Macedonia, cu sprijinul Fundației Friedrich Ebert;
- Conferința internațională „Integrarea europeană prin cooperarea parlamentelor, societății civile și a structurilor indepedente de reglementare din Sud-Estul Europei” (15-16 aprilie 2013) organizată de Parlamentului Republicii Macedonia și de filiala macedoneană a organizației European Movement.

Agenda reununii Grupului de lucru include, între altele, pregătirea proiectelor de documente pentru cea de-a zecea Conferință a Președinților de Parlamente din statele participante la SEECP (Ohrid, 27-28 mai 2013).

Programul prevede că reuniunea Grupului de lucru va fi precedată în ziua de 15 aprilie 2013 de întâlnirea pregătitoare a coordonatorilor naționali.

Potrivit Regulilor proprii de procedură, la lucrările Grupului de lucru privind instituționalizarea dimensiunii parlamentare a SEECP sunt invitați să participe membrii sau supleanții acestora, precum și coordonatorii naționali pe problematica SEECP. Organizatorii invită participanții la lucrările Grupului de lucru să ia parte și la lucrările Conferinței.

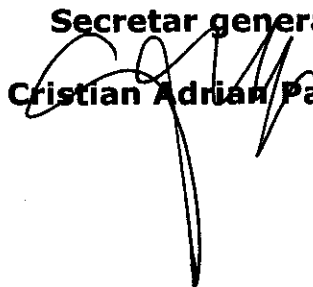
Organizatorii suportă costurile de cazare pentru primele două nopți la hotelul pe care îl recomandă și cele de transport local pe perioada programului din Skopje.

La aceste două acțiuni urmează să participe doamna deputat Gabriela-Maria Podașcă (PSD), aflată la prima participare ca reprezentantă a Camerei Deputaților în Grupul de lucru privind instituționalizarea dimensiunii parlamentare a SEECP, și domnul consilier Mario Ruse, coordonator național pe problematica SEECP din partea Camerei Deputaților.

Acțiunea are caracter parlamentar conform art. 3, litera d) din HBP nr. 1/2003 cu modificările și completările din HBP nr. 5/2007.

Propunem:

- să se aprobe participarea doamnei deputat Gabriela-Maria Podașcă și a domnului consilier Mario Ruse la acțiunile menționate;
- deplasarea să se efectueze cu avionul pe ruta București-Skopje și retur, cu plecare în ziua de 14 aprilie 2013, orele 20.50 (zbor OS 788) și întoarcere în ziua de 17 aprilie 2013, orele 20.05 (zbor OS 787) conform traseului anexat;
- să se acorde drepturi de diurnă categoria a II-a, 100% pentru 3 zile, cazare plafon B pentru 1 noapte (16-17 aprilie 2013) la hotelul recomandat de organizatori, precum și un avans de 50% cu decontare ulterioară;
- decontarea cheltuielilor să se facă la întoarcerea în țară, pe baza documentelor justificative.

Rules of Procedure and Scope of Activities of the Working group on further institutionalization of the SEECP Parliamentary Dimension

General provisions

- 1.** The Working Group is established in compliance with art. 16 of the Final Declaration of the 8th Conference of the SEECP Speakers of Parliament.
- 2.** The WG consists of one permanent member, one substitute member and the national coordinator appointed by the respective SEECP Parliament in compliance with art. 17 of the Final Declaration of the 8th Conference of the SEECP Speakers of Parliament.
- 3.** The first meeting of the Working Group will be held under the auspices of the SEECP CiO, the SEECP Troika and the SEECP Regional Secretariat in close cooperation with the RCC.
- 4.** The WG shall decide on the agenda, regularity and duration of its meetings.
- 5.** The final outcome of the Working Group shall be presented at the forthcoming Conference of the SEECP Speakers of Parliament.

Scope of activities

- 6.** The WG shall review and evaluate the overall development of the SEECP Parliamentary Dimension
- 7.** The WG shall deliberate on and adopt the Guidelines of Proceedings of the RSPC SEE according to the art. 14 of the Final Declaration of the 8th Conference of the SEECP Speakers of Parliament.
- 8.** The WG shall elaborate a report on the guidelines and modalities for further development of SEECP Parliamentary dimension and leading to setting up a Parliamentary Assembly.

Meetings

- 9.** The WG meetings are chaired by the representative of the Parliament of the SEECP CiO
- 10.** The WG meetings shall be convened by its Chairperson. Chairperson shall deliver notice of the agenda, time and venue of meetings through RSPC SEE and the national coordinators.
- 11.** Any member of the WG may invite individuals or representatives of legal entities to provide expertise on the issues considered by the WG.
- 12.** The WG decisions shall be made by a consensus.
- 13.** The national coordinators attend any meeting of the Working Group in a non-voting capacity.
- 14.** Summary minutes shall be drawn up at the meetings of the WG, setting out all the decisions made.

Decision making

- 15.** The draft documents for the WG meetings shall be prepared by the RSPC SEE in consultations with the SEECP CiO, the SEECP Troika and the national coordinators.
- 16.** The documents of the WG shall be adopted by a consensus.
- 17.** The report to the Conference of the SEECP Speakers of Parliament shall set out the decisions adopted by the WG, the different views on the matter /if any/and the arguments in support of each.
- 18.** The WG report to the Conference of the SEECP Speakers of Parliaments shall be delivered by the WG Chairperson.

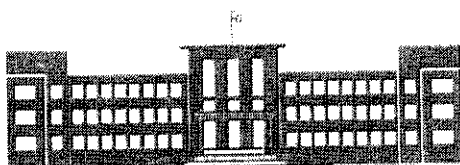

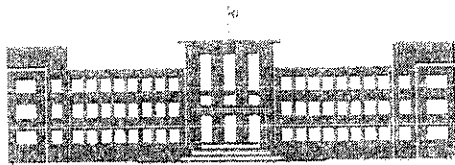

Dear members of the SEECP PD Working Group,

We have the special honor to inform you that in the framework of the Republic of Macedonia's Chairmanship-in-Office of the **South-East European Cooperation Process (SEECP)**, under the motto *Solidarity in Action*, the Assembly of the Republic of Macedonia and the European Movement in the Republic of Macedonia are organizing an International Conference on the topic: ***“European integration through cooperation of the parliaments, the civil society and the independent regulatory bodies in South East Europe”***. The International Conference is continuation of the Conference held in Belgrade (April 2012) aimed at establishing dialogue and exchange of experiences in the Euro-integration processes among the parliaments, the civil society organizations and the independent and other regulatory bodies in the region.

In the last decade the EU institutions, the European Movement and many other non-governmental and independent bodies, including those in the SEECP region, have repeatedly emphasized the need for a pro-active civil sector. The need for greater democratization and active citizens was especially emphasized in the countries aspiring for integration in the Union. In line with this, the European Commission, in cooperation with the European Movement International, adopted the Zadar Declaration and the Ljubljana Declaration that instigated a series of other initiatives for establishing dialogue.

The motivation and the suggestion to hold a conference on this topic was a result of the need for more information about the current developments in the European Union and the clearly expressed need for change that would lead to its internal consolidation. Additional motivation was the need for synergy and coordinated action regarding European integration processes of the bodies of the state, the non-governmental organizations and other independent entities that, despite the differences in their approach are working towards realization of the same goal.

The civil society organizations and the independent regulatory bodies that will be part of this conference have an exceptionally important role in the strengthening of democracy, development and implementation of the European regulations in various fields (promotion of human rights, protection of the environment and improvement of the quality of life, fight against corruption, free media, etc.). No less

important is the discussion on the EU enlargement, i.e. the open debate on the dilemmas and the specific path towards accession of the individual countries that are on different pre-accession level. The benefit of the conference for the public in general will be the shared experiences and the exchanged good practices, as well as the encouragement for greater solidarity in facing the new challenges in the European integration processes.

We expect that at the end of the conference a final document will be adopted that will be forwarded to the SEECP Summit of heads of state and government, the X Conference of the SEECP Speakers of Parliament, the European Movement International, the European Parliament, the European Commission, the OSCE Parliamentary Assembly, the Parliamentary Assembly of the Council of Europe, the Parliamentary Assembly of the Central European Initiative and the Regional Cooperation Council in order to encourage and support the projects and initiatives that will be proposed at the conference.

We would be very pleased if you would accept our invitation to be one of the introductory speakers at this important international conference that will be held on 15 and 16 April 2013 in the Assembly of the Republic of Macedonia.

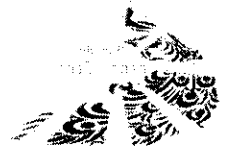
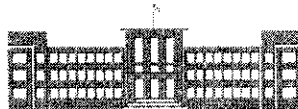
