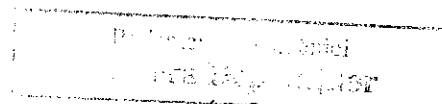

Luni, 14 octombrie 2013, la Londra, va avea loc *Seminarul privind rolul parlamentelor naționale în implementarea hotărârilor Curții Europene pentru Drepturile Omului (CEDO)*, organizat de Adunarea Parlamentară a Consiliului Europei (APCE).

Obiectivul seminarului este acela de a sprijini membrii parlamentelor naționale în perfecționarea cunoștințelor privind Curtea Europeană a Drepturilor Omului și în demersurile pentru asigurarea executării hotărârilor CEDO. De asemenea, seminarul își propune analizarea structurilor și mecanismelor la nivel parlamentar dedicate verificării îndeplinirii standardelor Convenției Europene a Drepturilor Omului. La eveniment sunt invitați să participe parlamentari din Croația, Grecia, Italia, Olanda, Polonia, România și Marea Britanie.

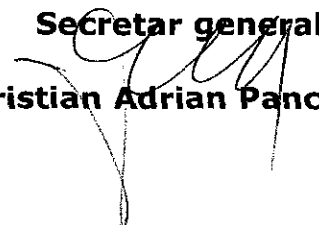

Dear Ms Gorghiu,

Following your appointment by the Romanian Parliament, I would like to confirm the invitation to attend the *Seminar on the role of parliaments in implementation of the judgments of the European Court of Human Rights* to be held in London on 14 October 2013. A preliminary programme and a participation form are attached.

The Parliamentary Assembly has been working, over a number of years, on the need to ensure more active involvement of parliaments in issues relating to the European Convention on Human Rights, and in particular the need for regular and rigorous parliamentary oversight of the judgments of the European Court of Human Rights. Several resolutions have been adopted by the Parliamentary Assembly on this subject, and I refer you in this connection, in particular, to "Resolution 1823 (2011) National Parliaments: guarantors of human rights in Europe".

The Parliamentary Project Support Division is to hold a series of seminars specifically for members of national parliaments on issues relating to the European Convention on Human Rights. For organisational reasons, each seminar will be addressed to a limited group of national parliaments. For this first seminar, which will focus on the execution of judgments of the ECHR, members from the following countries have been invited: Croatia, Greece, Italy, the Netherlands, Poland, Romania and the United Kingdom, and given your experience, your contribution to the discussion would be very much appreciated.

The Council of Europe will reimburse your travel and subsistence expenses in accordance with the attached memorandum. Specific travel related risks are covered by a CHARTIS **insurance** policy (number 2.004.761), which provides cover for persons up to their 76th birthday. The following help line CHARTIS Assistance 24 Hours can be called in case of need: + (32) 3 253 69 16. It is not necessary to take out a supplementary insurance policy and such a policy will not be reimbursed by the Council of Europe.

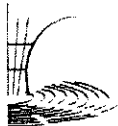

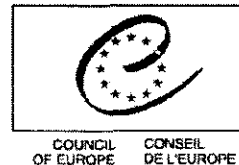

1. Objective

The main objective of this seminar is to support the members of national parliaments in improving their knowledge of the European Convention on Human Rights and in the need to effectively implement the judgments of the European Court of Human Rights. Another objective is to examine the existence of parliamentary structures and mechanisms for the verification of Convention standards.

2. Participants

The PACE in its Resolution 1914 (2013) "*Ensuring the viability of the Strasbourg Court: structural deficiencies in States Parties*" indicated that, inter alia, Croatia, Estonia, Romania and Ukraine had the highest number of applications in relation to their population.

PACE Resolution 1823 (2011) "*National parliaments: guarantors of human rights in Europe*" states that: "5. With respect to the implementation of judgments of the European Court of Human Rights, the Assembly (...) 5.3. points to the positive examples in several member states, notably the United Kingdom, the Netherlands, Germany, Finland and Romania, which have set up parliamentary structures to monitor the implementation of the Court's judgments".

Therefore, this first seminar could include representatives from 5-6 countries such as: Croatia, Estonia, Romania, Ukraine, the Netherlands and the United Kingdom.
