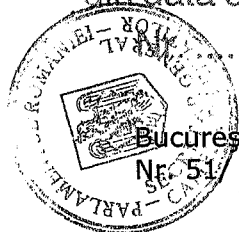

**Tema: Participarea la prima parte a Sesiunii ordinare 2013 a Adunării
Parlamentare a Consiliului Europei
(Strasbourg, 21 – 25 ianuarie 2013)**

În perioada 21 – 25 ianuarie 2013, la Strasbourg, vor avea loc lucrările primei părți a Sesiunii ordinare 2013 a Adunării Parlamentare a Consiliului Europei (APCE), la care urmează să participe domnul deputat **Ionuț Stroe** (PNL), membru supleant al Delegației Parlamentului României la APCE.

Menționăm că, potrivit regulamentului organizației, membrii unei delegații naționale își păstrează calitatea de membri ai Adunării până la constituirea unei noi delegații naționale.

Acțiunea are caracter parlamentar conform art. 3, litera a) din HBP nr. 1/2003 cu modificările și completările din HBP nr. 5/2007.

Propunem:

- să se aprobe participarea domnului deputat Ionuț Stroe la această acțiune;
- deplasarea să se efectueze cu avionul pe ruta București – Strasbourg și retur, cu plecare în data de 20.01.2013, ora 13.00 (RO 383) și întoarcere în data de 26.01.2013, ora 14.15 (RO 9384), conform traseului anexat;
- să se acorde drepturi de diurnă categoria a II-a, 100 %, pentru 6 ½ zile, cazare plafon B în numerar, pentru 6 nopți, întrucât rezervarea cazării se face prin intermediul Reprezentanței permanente a României pe lângă Consiliul Europei de la Strasbourg, precum și un avans de 50% cu decontare ulterioară;
- recalcularea cheltuielilor să se facă la întoarcerea în țară, pe baza documentelor justificative.

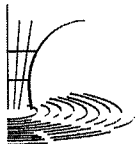
