Tema: Participarea la lucrările Comisiei pentru migrații, refugiați și persoane strămutate (Paris, 20 noiembrie 2013) și ale Biroului și Comisiei Permanente ale Adunării Parlamentare a Consiliului Europei (Viena, 21 – 22 noiembrie 2013)

La 20 noiembrie 2013, la Paris, va avea loc reuniunea Comisiei pentru migrații, refugiați și persoane strămutate a Adunării Parlamentare a Consiliului Europei (APCE), din care fac parte domnii deputați **Ionuț Stroe** (PNL), șeful delegației parlamentare române la APCE, și **Cezar Preda** (PDL). Pe ordinea de zi a Comisiei este prevăzută, printre altele, o audiere pe marginea situației refugiaților sirieni din țările învecinate în scopul organizării și susținerii de programe internaționale de asistență umanitară.

În perioada 21 – 22 noiembrie, la Viena, vor avea loc reuniunile Biroului și Comisiei Permanente ale APCE, din care face parte domnul deputat **Ionuț Stroe** (PNL), șeful delegației parlamentare române la APCE. Pe agenda lucrărilor Biroului Adunării se vor discuta și definitivă, printre altele, proiectul ordinii de zi a primei părți a Sesiunii ordinare 2014 a APCE.

Acțiunile au caracter parlamentar conform art. 3, alin. a) din HBPr nr. 1/2003, modificată și completată prin HBPr nr. 5/2007.

Propunem:

- să se aprobe participarea domnilor deputați **Ionuț Stroe** și **Cezar Preda** la acțiunile menționate;

- pentru domnul deputat Ionuț Stroe:
 - deplasarea să se efectueze pe ruta București-Paris-Viena-București, cu plecare în 19 noiembrie, ora 09:15, zbor RO 381 și întoarcere la București în 23 noiembrie, ora 20:25, zbor RO 344, conform traseului anexat;
 - să se acorde drepturi de diurnă categoria a II-a, 100% pentru 4 ½ zile, cazare plafon B pentru 2 nopți la Paris și 2 nopți la Viena, la hotelul recomandat de organizatori, precum și un avans de 20% cu decontare ulterioară;
- pentru domnul deputat Cezar Preda :
 - deplasarea să se efectueze pe ruta București-Paris și retur, cu plecare în 19 noiembrie, ora 09:15, zbor RO 381 și întoarcere la București în 21 noiembrie, ora 20:10, zbor RO 384, conform traseului anexat;
 - să se acorde drepturi de diurnă categoria a II-a, 100% pentru 2 ½ zile, cazare plafon B pentru 2 nopți, la hotelul solicitat de domnul deputat, precum și un avans de 20% cu decontare ulterioară;
- decontul cheltuielilor se va face la întoarcerea în țară, pe baza documentelor justificative.
