**Tema: Participarea la cea de-a treia parte a Sesiunii ordinare 2013
a Adunării Parlamentare a Consiliului Europei (24-28 iunie a.c.)**

În perioada 24 - 28 iunie 2013, la Strasbourg, va avea loc cea de-a treia parte a Sesiunii ordinare 2013 a APCE.

Pe ordinea de zi a celei de-a treia părți a Sesiunii sunt prevăzute, în Adunarea plenară, alocuțiunea Președintelui Parlamentului European, domnul Martin Schulz, votul privind solicitarea de începere a procedurii de monitorizare a Ungariei, alegerea judecătorilor pentru Curtea Europeană a Drepturilor Omului, cu candidaturi din partea Islandei, Lituaniei și Republicii Slovace, votul asupra unui proiect de opinie privind Protocol nr. 16 al Convenției pentru apărarea drepturilor omului și libertăților fundamentale, prezentarea rezultatelor misiunii de observare a alegerilor anticipate din Bulgaria, dezbateri pe următoarele teme: situația din Orientul Mijlociu, corupția ca o amenințare la adresa drepturilor omului, accesul la asistență medicală, delimitarea dintre răspunderea politică și răspunderea penală etc.

Pe lângă reuniunile zilnice în plen ale Adunării, au loc întâlniri la nivelul tuturor comisiilor permanente și reuniuni ale grupurilor politice ale APCE.

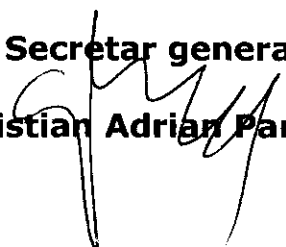
Menționăm că Grupul Partidului Popular European își va alege noul lider cu prilejul reuniunilor de la sfârșitul lunii iunie.

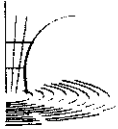

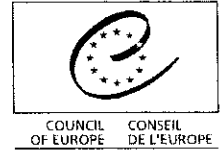
