- Tema:** Oportunitatea participării la cea de-a 18-a ediție a reuniunii internaționale *Mic dejun cu rugăciune – International Berlin Gathering* (Berlin, Republica Federală Germania, 6-8 iunie 2013) și la reuniunea internațională *Mic dejun național cu rugăciune* (Marea Britanie, Londra, 24-25 iunie 2013)

În perioada 6-8 iunie 2013, va avea loc la Berlin, sub egida Parlamentului Republicii Federale Germania (Bundestag), cea de-a 18-a ediție a reuniunii internaționale *Mic dejun cu rugăciune – International Berlin Gathering*, cu tema "Responsabilitate în fața lui Dumnezeu și a oamenilor", la care au fost invitați să participe domnul deputat **Mircea Lubanovici** (PDL), vicepreședinte al Grupului Ecumenic de Rugăciune din Parlamentul României și domnul deputat **Octavian Petric** (PSD), membru al acestui Grup.

Cheltuielile de participare sunt suportate de parlamentele naționale. Înscrierea participanților se face numai după achitarea prin transfer bancar a unei taxe în valoare de 390USD (290euro)/persoană. Precizăm că formularul de participare prevede și o contribuție financiară sub formă de donație.

Totodată, în perioada 24-25 iunie 2013, va avea loc Westminster Hall, Londra, sub egida Camerei Comunelor, reuniunea internațională 2013 *Mic dejun național cu rugăciune* cu tema "Dumnezeu și Societatea: Credința în Dumnezeu în Marea Britanie a secolului 21", pentru care au primit invitații de participare doamna deputat **Florica Cherecheș** (PNL) și domnul deputat **Mircea Lubanovici** (PDL), vicepreședinți ai Grupului Ecumenic de Rugăciune din Parlamentul României.

Cheltuielile de participare sunt suportate de parlamentele naționale. Pentru acest eveniment se solicită o taxă de 45£/persoană precum și oferirea unei donații, sume ce vor fi achitate prin transfer bancar.

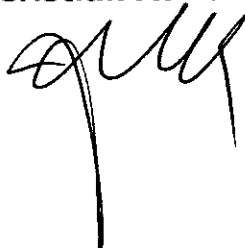
Marea Britanie, Republica Federală Germania, România, Bulgaria, Republica Moldova, etc.

18th International Berlin Gathering

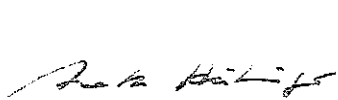
from June 6th to 8th, 2013

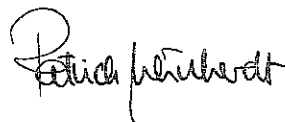

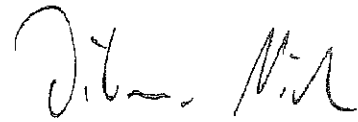

National Parliamentary Prayer Breakfast 2013

On behalf of the Christians in Parliament All Party Parliamentary Group and as this year's Chair, I am delighted to invite you to the 2013 National Parliamentary Prayer Breakfast, which will take place on Tuesday 25th June from 7.30am to 9.00am in Westminster Hall in the Houses of Parliament. The National Parliamentary Prayer Breakfast is held with the kind permission of the Speaker and the Lord Speaker and is an annual recognition of the contribution that Christianity makes to the national life of the UK.

It has been more than a century since Friedrich Nietzsche proclaimed the death of God. Throughout the first half of the 20th Century it was also argued that the rise of modernity would go hand in hand with the decline of religion. However, at the beginning of the 21st century the sociologists are revising their theories – across the world, religious faith is seeing explosive growth. However, the picture in the UK is a more complex one. While recent surveys report that traditional religious faith is declining, a recent Theos think tank report reveals that the proportion of people who are consistently non-religious is very low, at 9%. Furthermore, 35% of the people who describe themselves as "never participating in a religious service", at the same time express a belief in God or a Higher Power.

These significant social changes are the context for the theme of this year's event: '*God and Society: Belief in God in 21st Century Britain*'. We are delighted that our main speaker this year will be Professor John Lennox and he will be examining the rationality of belief in God in contemporary society. As well as being a Professor of Mathematics at the University of Oxford, John has debated with some of the world's leading atheists in recent years, such as Richard Dawkins, Christopher Hitchens and Peter Singer.

The Breakfast will also include contributions from members of both Houses of Parliament, a range of seminars in line with our theme, the opportunity to be taken on a tour of the Palace of Westminster, as well as to attend evensong and a tour of Westminster Abbey on the evening before.
