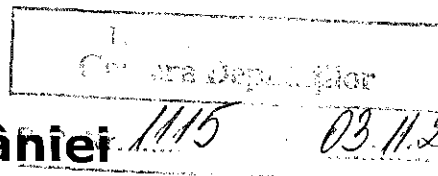

Tema: Participarea la cea de-a 8-a Sesiune a Adunării Consultative a parlamentarilor privind Curtea Penală Internațională și Statul de drept (Rabat, 4-5 decembrie 2014)

În perioada 4-5 decembrie 2014, va avea loc la Rabat, Maroc, cea de-a 8-a Sesiune a Adunării Consultative a parlamentarilor privind Curtea Penală Internațională și Statul de drept, organizată de rețeaua Parlamentari pentru Acțiune Globală.

Adunarea Consultativă a parlamentarilor privind Curtea Penală Internațională și Statul de drept este singura adunare globală a parlamentarilor dedicată în exclusivitate justiției și statului de drept și reprezintă principalul eveniment parlamentar internațional dedicat Curții Penale Internaționale, singura instanță penală internațională permanentă care are jurisdicție universală.

Pe agenda Adunării sunt prevăzute dezbateri în cadrul unor sesiuni tematice precum: Promovarea universalității Statutului de la Roma al Curții Penale Internaționale la 12 ani de la intrarea în vigoare a acestuia: provocări la adresa statelor și organizațiilor internaționale și rolul parlamentarilor, Activitatea Curții Penale Internaționale, Consolidarea statului de drept și a sistemului judiciar prin aplicarea eficientă a principiului complementarității (conform Statutului de la Roma), Contribuția parlamentarilor la cooperarea eficientă cu instituția Curții Penale Internaționale, Protecția integrității Statutului de la Roma, Impactul responsabilității și rolul Curții în ceea ce privește amenințările globale la adresa păcii, securității, stabilității și democrației. De asemenea, în cadrul sesiunii privind viitorul justiției penale internaționale va fi supus discuției Planul de acțiune de la Rabat privind Curtea Penală Internațională și Statul de drept.

Din partea Camerei Deputaților, la reuniune va participa domnul deputat **Vlase Petru Gabriel (PSD)**, Președintele Comisiei Permanente a Camerei Deputaților și Senatului privind Statutul deputaților și al senatorilor, organizarea și funcționarea ședințelor comune ale Camerei Deputaților și Senatului.

Acțiunea are caracter parlamentar, conform art. 3, litera d) din HBPr nr. 1/2003 cu modificările și completările din HBPr nr. 5/2007.

Propunem:

- să se aprobe participarea domnului deputat Vlase Petru Gabriel la acțiunea menționată;
- deplasarea să se efectueze cu avionul, pe ruta București-Paris-Rabat și retur, cu plecare în data de 3 decembrie a.c., ora 15:10 (AF1889) și întoarcere în data de 6 decembrie a.c., ora 23:00 (AF1088), conform traseului anexat;
- să se acorde drepturi de diurnă categoria a II-a, 100%, pentru 3 ½ zile, majorată cu 20 % conform art.27 alin (2) litera a) din HBPr nr. 1/2003 cu modificările și completările din HBPr nr. 5/2007), cazare plafon B pentru 3 nopți, precum și un avans de 50% cu decontare ulterioară;
- recalcularea cheltuielilor să se facă la întoarcerea în țară, pe baza documentelor justificative.

Consultative Assembly of Parliamentarians for the International Criminal Court (ICC) and the Rule of Law, (Parliament of Morocco, Rabat) 4-5 December, 2014

New York / The Hague (October 02, 2014):

As a member of Parliamentarians for Global Action it is our honour to inform you that the Speaker of the Moroccan House of Representatives and the President of PGA have co-signed a letter to invite the Speaker of all Chambers in the Houses of Parliament in which PGA Members are present in order to attend the *8th session of the Consultative Assembly of Parliamentarians for the International Criminal Court (ICC) and the Rule of Law*, to take place in the **Parliament of Morocco** in Rabat from 4-5 December, 2014. The *Consultative Assembly* is organized by Parliamentarians for Global Action (PGA), an NGO affiliated to the United Nations with a membership of over 1,100 Members of Parliament elected in 140 countries, striving to promote peace, democracy, the rule of law, human rights, non-discrimination and gender equality.

The letter invites not only your Speaker to attend this most important event of the PGA ICC Campaign for 2014, but also requests the Parliament to form an Official Delegation to represent your Legislature and contribute actively to the success of this action-oriented Consultative Assembly.

We therefore kindly urge you to ensure that your Speaker will respond positively to this invitation, preferably by **15 October 2014**, and that the leading PGA Members promoting the fight against impunity and the universality of the Rome Statute of the ICC be included in the official delegation of your Chamber. A copy of the official letter sent to your speaker is available upon request by writing to: cap-icc@pgaaction.org. Within the framework of its Campaign for the Universality and the Effectiveness of the Rome Statute System, PGA Members-Parliamentarians have contributed to 76 out of the 122 ratifications or accessions to the Rome Statute of the ICC and have played an important role in the national law-making process to implement the Statute in the domestic legal orders of more than 30 States. However, many challenges must be overcome to improve the impact of Legislators and other stakeholders in attaining an effective and universal system of national and international justice.

The *Consultative Assembly of Parliamentarians for the ICC and the Rule of Law* is the only global gathering of Legislators focused solely on the international justice and the Rule of Law. Its meetings represent a unique opportunity for Lawmakers from all regions of the world to discuss and define strategies on, and mobilize in support for, the fight against impunity and the prevention of the most serious crimes of concern to the international community as a whole, i.e. genocide, crimes against humanity and war crimes.

The first seven sessions of the *Consultative Assembly* were held in Ottawa, Canada (2002), New York, United Nations (2003), Wellington, New Zealand (2004), Tokyo, Japan (2006), Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic (2008), Kampala, Uganda (2010) and Rome, Italy (2012). Their respective deliberations have subsequently informed and inspired key initiatives and activities of several hundred Lawmakers from around the world on crucial justice and human rights' issues. The 2014 *Consultative Assembly*, which will coincide with the 36th Annual Parliamentary Forum of PGA, will not only mark its first session held in an Arab country, but also represents the main international parliamentary event on the ICC, the treaty that established the new permanent system of international criminal justice since 2002.

We would be honoured to benefit from your participation in this International conference and appreciate your confirmation preferably by **October 15, 2014** by filling and sending the registration form. We look forward to meeting you in Rabat to work together towards the realisation of PGA's vision, *the creation of a Rules-Based International Order for a more equitable, safe and democratic world*, through the establishment of a global parliamentary constituency for the ICC.
