

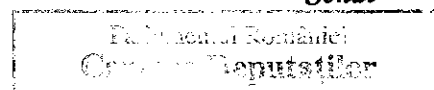

INFORMARE privind participarea la lucrările Secretariatului Internațional al Adunării Interparlamentare a Ortodoxiei (AIO) - 22 – 25 noiembrie 2014, Nicosia -

În perioada 22-25 noiembrie 2014 s-au desfășurat la Nicosia-Cipru, lucrările Secretariatului Internațional al Adunării Interparlamentare a Ortodoxiei la care au participat și președinții comisiilor de specialitate ale Adunării Interparlamentare a Ortodoxiei.

La lucrări au luat parte 29 de parlamentari din 16 țări, membri ai Adunării Interparlamentare a Ortodoxiei, precum și 13 alți invitați.

Din România au participat domnii deputați Petru Andea, membru al Secretariatului Internațional al Adunării Interparlamentare a Ortodoxiei și Miron Ignat, președintele Comisiei de probleme sociale și familiale a Adunării Interparlamentare a Ortodoxiei.

În programul lucrărilor Secretariatului au fost incluse informări privind acțiunile organizate de Adunarea Interparlamentară a Ortodoxiei în anul 2014, cum au fost cea de-a 21-a Adunare Generală, desfășurată la Moscova – 25-30 iunie 2014 și reuniunea Comisiei Adunării Interparlamentare a Ortodoxiei pentru activități sociale și familiale, desfășurată tot la Moscova în perioada 9-12 septembrie a.c.

A fost prezentată o informare despre participarea unei delegații a Adunării Interparlamentare a Ortodoxiei la Micul Dejun cu Rugăciune organizat de Parlamentul României la Mănăstirea Putna, în perioada 24-27 septembrie 2014. Acțiunea a fost elogios apreciată și s-a avansat propunerea ca Adunarea Interparlamentară a Ortodoxiei să fie acceptată ca partener la organizarea ediției 2015 a Micului Dejun cu Rugăciune din Parlamentul României.

Programul lucrărilor a inclus întâlniri cu Preafericitul Arhiepiscop al Noii Iustiniane și al Întregului Cipru, Hrisostom II, cu ministrul de externe al Republicii Cipru, domnul Ioannis Kasolides, cu Președintele Camerei Reprezentanților Republicii Cipru, domnul Omirou L. Yiannakis.

În discuțiile purtate cu oficialii ciprioți (greci) au fost subliniate eforturile ce se depun pentru unificarea Ciprului, au fost criticate repetatele provocări prin care Turcia împiedică acest proces.

Programul complet al reuniunii din Cipru este anexat.

Discuțiile purtate în cadrul ședințelor Secretariatului Internațional al Adunării Interparlamentare a Ortodoxiei au abordat problema actuală a persecuțiilor împotriva creștinilor din Orientul Apropiat, în special cele comise de Statul Islamic. În sensul condamnării acestor persecuții s-au pronunțat reprezentanții Patriarhiei Antiohiei, ai Bisericii Ortodoxe din Cipru, ai Parlamentelor Suediei și Armeniei.

A fost evocat genocidul comis acum 100 de ani împotriva armenilor din Imperiul Otoman și s-a aprobat participarea, în aprilie 2015, la Erevan, la o conferință evocatoare cu tema: „Democrație parlamentară - Religie – Memorie istorică comună”.

Draftul propus pentru programul Conferinței este anexat.

S-a aprobat deasemenea participarea unei delegații a Adunării Interparlamentare a Ortodoxiei la Micul Dejun cu Rugăciune, organizat la Bruxelles, în 2-3 decembrie a.c., de Parlamentul European precum și organizarea, la Atena, în perioada 28-29 ianuarie 2015 a unei conferințe cu tema „Societatea Civilă – Noua Tehnologie - Democrația directă”.

Viitoarea Adunare generală a Adunării Interparlamentare a Ortodoxiei va fi organizată în iunie 2015, la Viena sau la Paris.

Reuniunea Secretariatului Internațional al Adunării Interparlamentare a Ortodoxiei a mai cuprins participarea la servicii religioase, vizitarea unor mănăstiri ș.a.

Delegația Parlamentului României a avut o întâlnire cu ambasadorul României în Cipru, Excelența Sa Ion Pascu, care ne-a consiliat cu privire la specificul vieții politice și religioase din Cipru și din zonă.

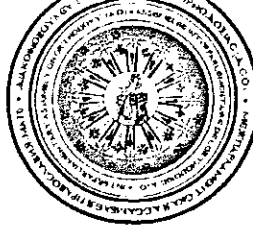

Thursday, 29 January 2015

1st Session: PARLIAMENTARY DEMOCRACY AND MODERN SOCIETY. VALUES – CONCEPTS

In THIS Session the concepts of democracy and parliamentarism in the context of new technologies and globalization era WILL BE APPROACHED; aiming at the critical evaluation of representative democracy, citizens' democratic participation in decision making, within the framework of civil society. Moreover, citizens' attitude and their collective expressions on proposals of direct participation in decision making processes will be explored as well.

2nd Session: PARTICIPATORY DEMOCRACY – CIVIL SOCIETY
AND NEW TECHNOLOGIES

This session will attempt to record and evaluate the – up – to date possibilities provided by new technologies and the way they have contributed to the formation and expression of opinion and participation at different levels and decision-making planes; a critical evaluation of the possibilities provided by states' institutional laws and especially of the European Union; an overview of initiatives already undertaken by various organizations and institutions, such as the UN etc.

3rd Session: PARTICIPATORY DEMOCRACY AND FUTURE
TECHNOLOGIES

In this session potential future technological possibilities relating to decision-making procedures and direct democracy will be presented. Moreover, results and conclusions of research reports and projects referring to citizens' and institutions attitude towards new technologies and direct democracy will be presented as well.
