Dear Mr. Panciu,

I am contacting you to ask for your support with the launch of a book of photographs jointly produced by the Irish charity organisation Comber and Hope and Homes for Children Romania. The book, which is the initiative of Comber volunteer Ms. Triona Collins, attempts to show disability in a positive light.

Comber has been active in Romania for over 20 years, particularly in the area of deinstitutionalisation of people with disabilities. Rather than focusing on the negative messages around institutionalisation, the book contains a range of photographs of people with disabilities living in ordinary family situations. By focusing on a positive message instead, the intended outcomes are to improve the understanding for need to increase support for families with individuals with disabilities and to increase awareness about living with a disability.

In order to ensure a maximum impact, we are looking at organising the book launch together with a photo exhibition at the beginning of June in the prestigious venue of the Palace of Parliament. It is anticipated that guests at the launch, which will be opened by the Irish Ambassador, will include elected members, local authority officials and representatives of the government. Deputy Ana Birchall is a supporter of this request.

The Embassy of Ireland would appreciate it if the launch could be facilitated in area of the main hallways of the Chamber of Deputies building, in particular on either level S1 or P1, for a period of a week. This would render the exhibition the visibility it deserves and help achieve its goals of preventing institutionalisation of individuals with disabilities in Romania and reducing stigma towards those with disabilities.

I hope that you might give favourable consideration to this important project. We would therefore welcome an early opportunity to explore the idea with yourself or your staff.
