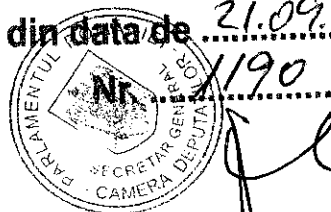

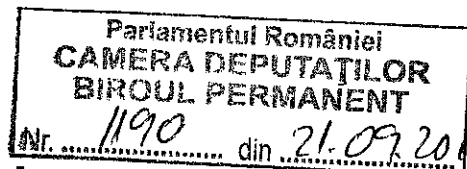

**Tema: Participarea la Summit-ul Forumului Global al Femeilor din Parlamente
2015 (WIP), Ciudad de Mexico, 7-9 octombrie 2015**

Forumul Global al Femeilor din Parlamente (WIP) și Senatul Mexican au adresat o scrisoare conducerii Camerei Deputaților privind participarea la Summit-ul Forumului Global al Femeilor din Parlamente 2015 (WIP), ce va loc la Ciudad de Mexico, la sediul Ministerului Afacerilor Externe, în perioada 7-9 octombrie 2015.

Summit-ul Forumului Global al Femeilor din Parlamente 2015 va marca a 40 – a aniversare a primei Conferințe Mondiale a Națiunilor Unite privind Statutul Femeilor, ce a avut loc în Mexic, în anul 1975.

Totodată, Summit-ul are loc în Mexic, în contextul reformei constituționale din această țară, legea fundamentală stipulând în prezent obligativitatea respectării egalității de gen în compunerea listelor de candidați pentru alegerile electorale.

Reuniunea va oferi participanților oportunitatea unor dezbateri pe teme globale de o importanță deosebită și a unor schimburi de experiențe între parlamentari și lideri la nivel mondial.

În ședința din data de 9 septembrie 2015, Biroul Permanent al Camerei Deputaților a solicitat Grupurilor parlamentare să nominalizeze câte un parlamentar, în vederea constituirii unei delegații care să reprezinte Camera Deputaților la acest eveniment.

Astfel, au fost nominalizate doamnele **Tamara-Dorina Ciofu**, vicepreședinta Comisiei pentru drepturile omului, culte și problemele minorităților naționale și doamna Marcela Monica Stoica, consilier în cadrul aceleiași Comisii (care nu solicită suportarea cheltuielilor de transport și cazare din bugetul Camerei Deputaților), din partea **Grupului Parlamentar al Partidului Social Democrat (PSD)**; **Cornelia Negruț**, membră a Comisiei pentru buget, finanțe și bănci, din partea **Grupului Parlamentar Alianța Liberalilor și Democraților (ALDE)**; **Maria-Andreea Paul**, vicepreședinta Comisiei pentru egalitatea de șanse pentru femei și bărbați, din partea **Grupului Parlamentar Național Liberal**; **Liliana Ciobanu**, membră a Comisiei pentru agricultură, silvicultură, industrie alimentară și servicii specifice, din partea **Grupului Parlamentar Național Democrat (ND)**.

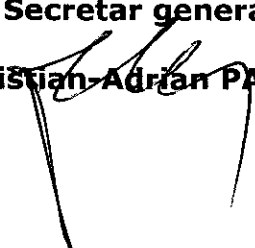
Acțiunea are caracter parlamentar conform art. 3, alin. e, al HBPr 1/2003, modificată și completată prin HBPr 5/2007.

Propunem:

- să se aprobe participarea delegației mai sus menționate la acest Summit;
- deplasarea doamnelor deputat să se efectueze cu avionul, clasa business, pe ruta București-Madrid-Mexic și retur, cu plecare în data de 6 octombrie a.c., ora 08.15, zbor UX 3702 și întoarcere în data de 12 octombrie a.c., ora 01.05, zbor UX 3701;
- doamnelor parlamentar să se acorde drepturi de diurnă categoria a II-a, 100%, pentru 6 zile, cazare plafon B pentru 5 nopți, la hotelul recomandat de organizatori, precum și un avans de 20% cu decontare ulterioară;
- doamnei consilier Marcela Monica Stoica să se acorde drepturi de diurnă categoria a II-a, 100% pentru 6 zile;
- pentru doamnele parlamentar să se suporte din bugetul Camerei Deputaților cheltuielile privind serviciile de asigurare contra accidentelor și asigurare de sănătate, în perioada efectivă de deplasare; până la finalizarea procedurii de atribuire a unui nou contract având ca obiectiv achiziția de servicii de asigurare contra accidentelor și asigurare de sănătate, să se aprobe achiziția acestor servicii prin cerere de ofertă de la agenții economici semnatar ai Acordului-cadru nr. 8/223/08.04.2015 pentru servicii de transport aerian internațional de pasageri;
- recalcularea cheltuielilor să se facă la întoarcerea în țară, pe baza documentelor justificative.

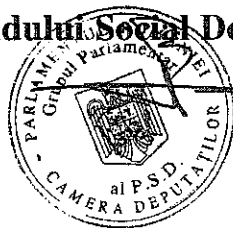
Camerei Deputaților iar pentru doamna consilier Marcela Monica Stoica, transportul se va suporta din bugetul personal.

WORKING GROUP 1: VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN: STATUS, PROGRESS AND CHALLENGES

ORGANISED BY THE MEXICAN SENATE

Exploring different laws and regulation that prevent violence against women, this working session will discuss the remaining risks and challenges of violence and discrimination

against women. It will focus on the implementation of legal instruments that prevent violence against women and promote women's rights.



WORKING GROUP 2:

DISASTER RISK REDUCTION - ENGAGING WOMEN FOR BETTER SOLUTIONS

ORGANISED BY UNISDR

Disaster affects men and women differently. Involving female Parliamentarians is a crucial ingredient to building national and regional disaster resilience that also takes into account gender-specific vulnerabilities. This working group will bring together Parliamentarians and representatives from the Private Sector with the aim to catalyze disaster risk sensitive investment. It will highlight the need to increase the understanding of disaster risk and to create appropriate regulations. The working session will ultimately result in a set of recommendations for the private sector on how to participate in the creation of necessary policy and legislative frameworks.



WORKING GROUP 3: MAKING THE MOST OF NEW MEDIA TOOLS
