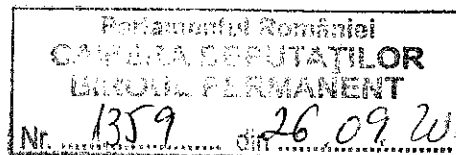

Tema: Participarea la cea de-a 16-a Conferință anuală inter-parlamentară privind energia regenerabilă și eficiența energetică (Copenhaga, Danemarca, 7 – 8 octombrie 2016)

În perioada 7 – 8 octombrie 2016, la Copenhaga, Parlamentul danez găzduiește cea de-a 16-a Conferință anuală inter-parlamentară privind energia regenerabilă și eficiența energetică organizată de EUFORES, la care au fost invitați să participe domnii deputați **Mihai Tararache (PNL)**, membru al Comisiei pentru industrii și servicii și **Valeriu Ștefan Zgonea (deputat neafiliat)**, membru al Comisiei pentru drepturile omului, culte și problemele minorităților naționale.

Conferința de anul acesta va fi structurată pe cinci sesiuni în care vor fi dezbătute următoarele teme: *Dimensiunea de politică externă în ceea ce privește tranziția energetică; Cum putem ajunge la o Uniune Energetică Europeană; Uniunea Europeană ca lider mondial în energia regenerabilă – iluzie sau noi oportunități pentru industria europeană, sectorul serviciilor și cel financiar?; Eficiența energetică – principalul combustibil al Europei și al întregii lumi; Noua legislație europeană în ceea ce privește eficiența energetică.*

În centrul discuțiilor se vor afla și obiectivele strategiei-cadru pentru o Uniune Energetică Europeană, printre care se numără: *Securitatea energetică, Piața internă a energiei, Contribuția eficienței energetice, Decarbonizarea economiei și Cercetarea, inovarea și competitivitatea.*

În cadrul conferinței sunt prevăzute alocuțiuni ce vor fi susținute de către personalități precum doamna Federica Mogherini, Înalțul reprezentant al UE pentru afaceri externe și politică de securitate și Vicepreședinte al Comisiei Europene, domnul Maroš Šefčovič, Vicepreședintele Comisiei Europene pentru Uniunea Energiei, domnul Kristian Jensen, Ministrul Afacerilor Externe al Regatului Danemarcei, domnul Rainer Baake, Secretarul de Stat în Ministerul Federal al Economiei și Energiei din Germania și domnul Jan Geiss, Secretarul general EUFORES.

Acțiunea are caracter parlamentar conform art. 3, lit. e din HBPr 1/2003 cu modificările și completările ulterioare din HBPr 5/2007.

Propunem:

- să se aprobe participarea domnilor deputați Mihai Tararache și Valeriu Ștefan Zgonea la această acțiune;
- deplasarea să se efectueze cu avionul pe ruta București-Berlin-Copenhaga și retur, clasa economic, cu plecare în data de 06 octombrie 2016, ora 06:30 (AB 8273) și întoarcere în data de 10 octombrie 2016, ora 00:45 (AB 8272), conform traseului anexat;
- să se acorde delegației Camerei Deputaților la această acțiune drepturi de diurnă categoria a II-a, 100%, pentru 4 zile și cazare plafon B pentru 3 nopți, conform art. 33 alin. 1) din HBPr nr. 5/2007, la hotelul recomandat de organizatori;
- să se acorde un avans de 20% cu decontare ulterioară și, totodată, să se suporte din acesta eventuale alte taxe suplimentare precum taxele de oraș sau sejur percepute de hotel;
- să se suporte din bugetul Camerei Deputaților cheltuielile privind serviciile de asigurare contra accidentelor și asigurare de sănătate pentru perioada efectivă de deplasare;
- decontul cheltuielilor se va face la întoarcerea în țară, pe baza documentelor justificative.

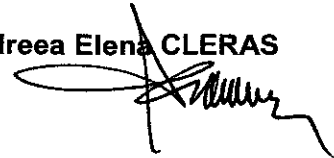

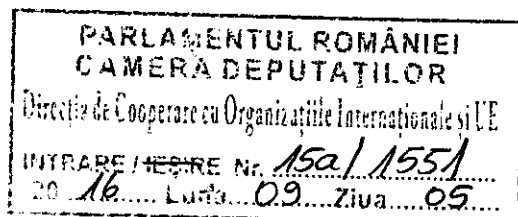

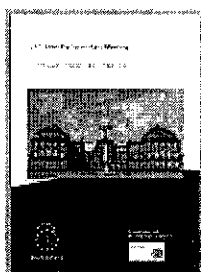
The EU Energy Union implies huge potentials in terms of energy security - both when it comes to internal and external security.
