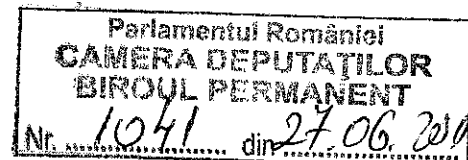

**Tema: Participarea la cea de-a treizecea reuniune a Biroului Adunării
Parlamentare a Mediteranei (Rabat, Maroc, 11 iulie 2016)**

Secretarul General al Adunării Parlamentare a Mediteranei (APM), domnul Sergio Piazzi a adresat invitația Președintelui Camerei Deputatilor și membrilor Delegației Parlamentului României la APM să participe, alături de omologi din parlamentele membre, la cea de-a treizecea reuniune a Biroului Adunării Parlamentare a Mediteranei, ce va avea loc în Rabat, Maroc, în data de 11 iulie 2016.

Această reuniune reprezintă un pas important în procesul de analiză și revizuire atât a bunei funcționări a Adunării Parlamentare a Mediteranei, cât și în adaptarea structurilor APM în scopul unei abordări mai eficiente a provocărilor cu care se confruntă regiunea.

Conferința va fi structurată în trei sesiuni, care se vor concentra asupra unor probleme prioritare pentru statele membre, printre care menționăm: amenințări și provocări de securitate și stabilitate, evoluțiile economice și protecția mediului, migrația și extremismul violent.

La această acțiune vor participa Președintele Camerei Deputatilor, șeful Delegației Parlamentului României la APM, domnul deputat **Florin Iordache (PSD)**, alături de domnul deputat **Ionaș - Florin Urcan (PNL)**, membru al Delegației, și de doamna Andreea-Elena Cleras, directorul general al Direcției generale pentru afaceri externe.

Cu același prilej, Președintele Camerei Deputatilor, domnul Florin Iordache va avea o întrevedere bilaterală cu domnul Rachid Talbi Alami, președintele Camerei Reprezentanților din Parlamentul marocan.

Acțiunea are caracter parlamentar conform art. 3, lit. a, al HBP 1/2003 modificată și completată prin HBP 5/2007.

Propunem:

- să se aprobe participarea domnilor deputați Florin Iordache și Ionaș - Florin Urcan, precum și a doamnei Andreea-Elena Cleras la această acțiune;
- deplasarea delegației să se efectueze cu avionul, pe ruta București - Paris - Rabat și retur, clasa business, cu plecare în data de 9 iulie a.c., ora 07.10 (AF1089) și întoarcere în data de 12 iulie a.c., ora 17.05 (AF1088), conform traseului anexat;
- pentru domnul Președinte Florin Iordache să se acorde drepturi de diurnă categoria a II-a, 100% pentru 3 ½ zile, majorată cu 50%, conform art. 27, alin. 2, lit. a, din HBPr 1/2003 cu modificările și completările ulterioare, și cazare pentru 3 nopți, în condițiile art. 32 alin. 4 din HBPr 1/2003 cu modificările și completările ulterioare;
- pentru domnul deputat Ionaș - Florin Urcan și doamna Andreea-Elena Cleras, să se acorde drepturi de diurnă categoria a II-a, 100% pentru 3 ½ zile, cazare plafon B pentru 3 nopți;
- să se suporte din bugetul Camerei Deputaților contravaloarea unor cadouri simbolice, în conformitate cu art. 57, alin. 1, lit. b din HBPr 1/2003 cu modificările și completările ulterioare din HBPr 5/2007;
- să se suporte din bugetul Camerei Deputaților, pentru întreaga delegație un avans de 50% cu decontare ulterioară și, totodată, să se suporte din acesta eventualele taxe de oraș percepute de hotel;
- să se suporte din bugetul Camerei Deputaților cheltuielile privind serviciile de asigurare contra accidentelor și asigurare de sănătate pentru perioada efectivă de deplasare;
- recalcularea cheltuielilor să se facă la întoarcerea în țară pe baza documentelor justificative.

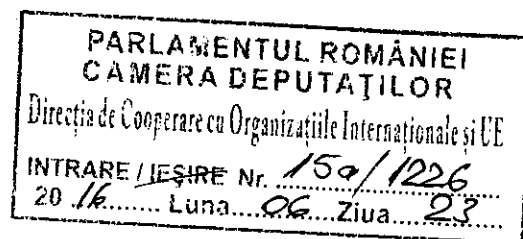

Excellency,

On behalf of PAM President, Sen. Lhou Lmarbouh, and as discussed during the PAM 10th Plenary Session in Tirana last February, I am pleased to inform you that the 30th PAM Bureau meeting will be taking place in Rabat, Morocco, on 11 July 2016, generously hosted by H.E. Abdelhakim Benchamach, President of the House of Councillors of the Kingdom of Morocco.

As suggested and agreed in Albania, this Bureau meeting will be held in an extended format. Therefore, all the national delegations of PAM Member Parliaments are invited to attend and contribute to the broad discussions on how to enhance the performance of our Assembly in a region that has completely changed in the last ten years.

As you may recall, a few months ago, we distributed a questionnaire to all delegations and PAM stakeholders in order to collect their views on the challenges ahead and the best way for PAM to respond to them. An independent Panel, composed of senior members of PAM and of experts, has been formed under the Presidency of Sen. Amoruso of Italy.

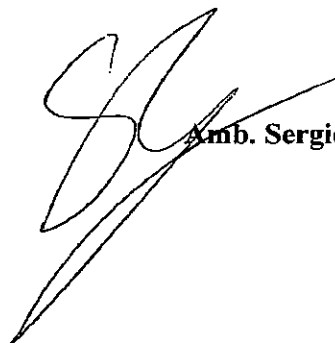
A preliminary work has been conducted by an expert who assists Sen. Amoruso, and this meeting in Rabat represents a step in the process of analyzing and reviewing, on one hand, the functioning of the Assembly and, on the other hand, the perceived needs rising from the challenges faced by the Mediterranean today.

The discussions in Rabat will be very broad in order to allow an open debate aimed at identifying practical recommendations, which will be then collected for the independent Panel which, after analyzing them, will submit them to the PAM President in view of the next Plenary Session. The preliminary work that the expert provided is being translated and will be made available to you soon, and will represent a good base for the discussions in Rabat.

Furthermore, several meetings on parliamentary diplomacy are simultaneously taking place in the region. For instance, the Parliament of Algeria convened, on 24-25 May in Algiers, an international meeting on parliamentary diplomacy where PAM played an important role. The University of Zaragoza and the Institute of International Economic Relations of Athens organized, on 26-28 May in Athens, a workshop on Security and Stability in the Mediterranean, and on 13-17 June, the Diplomatic Academy of Vienna, together with the International Organization of La Francophonie, will hold a workshop on the role of parliaments within international relations. These activities reveal, one more time, the importance of the tool of the parliamentary diplomacy that PAM has been fostering since its establishment, and we will take advantage from the outcome of these events as well.

Therefore, we encourage the broad participation of our National delegations as the discussions are very important and will contribute to shape the future of our Assembly for the good of our region.

While looking forward to seeing you in Rabat, please accept, Excellency, the assurance of my highest consideration.

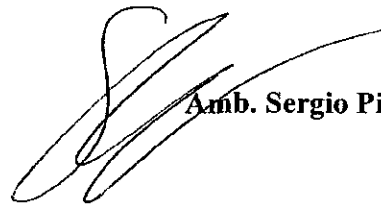
