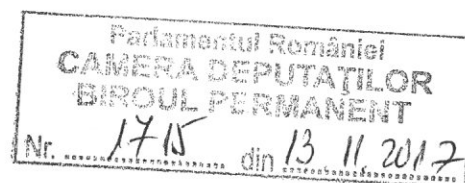

Tema: Participarea la reuniunea interparlamentară a Comisiei pentru drepturile femeilor și egalitate de gen din Parlamentul European (Bruxelles, 21 noiembrie 2017)

În data de 21 noiembrie 2017, la Bruxelles, cu ocazia Zilei Internaționale pentru Eliminarea Violenței împotriva Femeilor 2017, Comisia pentru drepturile femeilor și egalitate de gen din Parlamentul European - FEMM va organiza reuniunea interparlamentară intitulată "*Convenția de la Istanbul: combaterea violenței împotriva femeilor la nivel național și la nivelul UE*". La această acțiune, Camera Deputaților va fi reprezentată de doamna deputat **Oana-Mioara BÎZGAN-GAYRAL**, președintele Comisiei pentru egalitatea de șanse pentru femei și bărbați.

Pe agenda reuniunii sunt prevăzute prezentări și dezbateri pe următoarele teme: *Convenția de la Istanbul în statele membre UE: ratificare și monitorizare; Practica celor 4 "P" (prevention, protection, prosecution, policies): cum abordează statele membre violența de gen și violența domestică; Calea Uniunii Europene către Convenția de la Istanbul*. Scopul acestei reuniuni este de a evalua stadiul ratificării și implementării Convenției de la Istanbul la nivelul UE și la nivel național, precum și evaluarea acțiunilor de monitorizare ale GREVIO (Group of Experts on Action against Violence against Women and Domestic Violence – Council of Europe).

Reuniunea va fi prezidată de doamna **Vilija BLINKEVIČIŪTĖ**, Președintele Comisiei pentru drepturile femeilor și egalitate de gen din Parlamentul European – FEMM, iar printre participanții la această reuniune se numără membrii parlamentelor naționale din UE, experți naționali, reprezentanți ai Comisiei Europene, Institutului European pentru Egalitate de Gen, GREVIO – Consiliul Europei, Adunării Parlamentară a Consiliului Europei și ai ONG-urilor.

Totodată, în data de 21 noiembrie 2017, doamna deputat Bîzgan-Gayral a fost invitată să ia parte la sesiunea intitulată "*Sporirea democrației: implicarea femeilor în procesul politic*" ce se va desfășura în marja *Colocviului anual privind drepturile fundamentale 2017* organizat de Comisia Europeană la Bruxelles, în perioada 20-21 noiembrie a.c.

Acțiunea are caracter parlamentar conform art. 3, alin. c) din HBPr nr. 1/2003, modificată și completată prin HBPr nr. 5/2007.

Propunem:

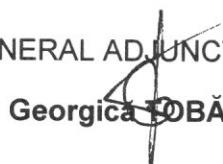
- să se aprobe participarea doamnei deputat Oana-Mioara BÎZGAN-GAYRAL la această acțiune;

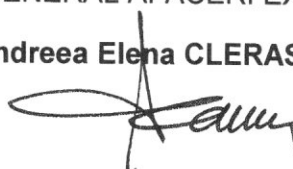

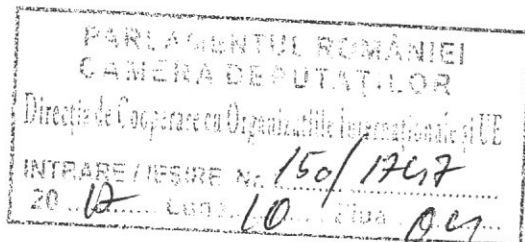

Dear colleague,

Following the tradition to celebrate the International Day for the elimination of Violence against Women, the Committee on Women's Rights and Gender Equality proposes this year to bring together European and National Parliamentarians around the theme:

"The Istanbul Convention: combating violence against women at national and EU level"

The aim of the Inter-parliamentary Committee meeting (ICM) is to assess what is the state of the ratification and implementation of the Istanbul Convention at EU and national levels and how it is being monitored by GREVIO.

The ICM will be organised around three panels:

- Panel 1 - The Istanbul Convention in the Member States: ratification and monitoring.
- Panel 2 - The 4 Ps in practice: how Member States tackle gender based violence and domestic violence.
- Panel 3 - The path to the EU accession to the Istanbul Convention.

After the panels a reception organised in cooperation with the European Institute for Gender Equality will take place in ASP building, MEP saloon, as part of its White Ribbon campaign.

The event is taking place in a year that the EU is especially devoting to prevent and combat violence against women. The signature by the EU of the Council of Europe Convention on preventing and combating violence against women and domestic violence (the Istanbul Convention) has been the major milestone of 2017 in the common task of fighting gender-based violence. The ICM and the European Commission Annual Colloquium on Fundamental Rights, that will be devoted to Women's Rights and will also take place in November, are part of this EU collective effort that would be strengthened with your support.

We are therefore very pleased to invite up to four Members of the corresponding committee(s) of each National Parliament (two from each chamber in the case of bi-cameral Parliaments) to attend this event on **Tuesday, 21 November 2017 from 15.00 to 18.30 in the European Parliament in Brussels.**

Your participation in this event, for which we expect the attendance of several MEPs and members of national parliaments from EU Member States as well as representatives of international organisations, would be an ideal opportunity for you to meet a wide variety of parliamentarians from across the EU.

Practical details regarding the meeting will be forwarded in due course to your Parliament's representatives/services responsible for relations with the European Parliament.

Annual Colloquium on Fundamental Rights 2017 "Women's Rights in Turbulent Times"

Women's and girls' rights need promotion and protection, as they continue to be challenged. Any regression is unacceptable. Gender equality has been a core value since the very creation of the European Union. The promotion and protection of the rights of women and girls are crucial for achieving social justice, building resilient democratic societies, and achieving sustainable development, as set out in the Agenda 2030.

The 2017 Colloquium aims to expand political engagement, to activate all stakeholders, and to improve mutual cooperation for the promotion and protection of the fundamental rights of women and girls. Politicians, representatives of civil society, activists, leading academics, businesses and trade unions, media representatives, journalists, and international organisations will reflect together on the relationship between the fulfilment of fundamental rights for women, and pluralism, solidarity, tolerance, justice and equality.

The wide range of topics for discussion will include the presence and normalisation of misogyny in society and its links to the violation of the fundamental rights of women in all spheres of life; the key obstacles to gender equality in economic empowerment and political participation; the international women's movement and the shifting space for civil society; violence against women and links to other forms of violence in society, including in the context of populist and extremist movements; the gendered nature of hate speech, racism, and other forms of discrimination. The discussions during this event will explore avenues for action to ensure women's rights and work towards gender equality in the EU.

This Colloquium meets in the form of a roundtable where all will discuss on an equal footing and in an interactive manner how EU institutions, EU Member States, International Organisations, NGOs, trade unions, employers, academics, journalists and media representatives can promote fundamental rights for all women and girls. Each session will be introduced by short "impulse statements" to trigger the discussion. The floor will then immediately be opened to the roundtable participants.
