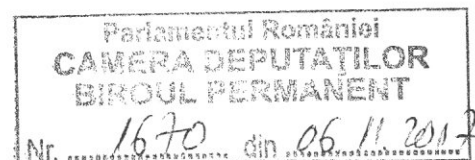

Tema: Participarea la lucrările Conferinței Națiunilor Unite privind Schimbările Climatice (COP23) (Bonn, 11 – 14 noiembrie 2017) și ale Comisiei pentru respectarea obligațiilor și angajamentelor asumate de statele membre ale Consiliului Europei a APCE (Paris, 15 noiembrie 2017)

Comisia pentru afaceri sociale, sănătate și dezvoltare durabilă a Adunării Parlamentare a Consiliului Europei (APCE) în ședința sa de la Strasbourg, din 24 aprilie 2017, i-a nominalizat pe domnii **Cezar Preda (PNL)**, membru al delegației Parlamentului României la APCE, și Lordul John Prescott, membru al delegației Parlamentului Marii Britanii la APCE, să reprezinte Comisia APCE la Conferința Națiunilor Unite privind Schimbările Climatice (COP23), de la Bonn, în **perioada 11 – 14 noiembrie 2017**.

De asemenea, cei doi parlamentari vor participa, în data de 12 noiembrie 2017, la reuniunea parlamentară organizată de Uniunea Interparlamentară, în colaborare cu Parlamentul din Fiji și Parlamentul Germaniei, în marja COP23. Printre temele principale ce vor fi supuse dezbaterii se regăsesc: „Promovarea Acordului de la Paris”, „Economie cu emisii reduse de carbon: Care este rolul legiuitorilor?”, „Schimbările climatice: Ce este în joc? Care este miza?”, „Migrația indusă de factorii climatici: Următoarea provocare?”.

În data de **15 noiembrie 2017**, la Paris, vor avea loc lucrările Comisiei pentru respectarea obligațiilor și angajamentelor asumate de statele membre ale Consiliului Europei a Adunării Parlamentare a Consiliului Europei (APCE) la care urmează să participe domnul deputat **Cezar Preda (PNL)**, președintele Comisiei APCE și membru al delegației Parlamentului României la APCE.

Pe agenda lucrărilor Comisiei APCE figurează spre dezbateră și adoptare o serie de proiecte de rapoarte și rezoluții privind: funcționarea instituțiilor democratice în Polonia; examinarea raportului preliminar pentru țări care nu se află sub procedura de monitorizare sau care nu sunt angajate într-un dialog post-monitorizare: Estonia, Grecia și Irlanda; recente evoluții din Armenia și Republica Moldova; precum și reuniunea Subcomisiei privind conflictele dintre statele membre ale Consiliului Europei în cadrul căreia se va organiza o masă rotundă pe tema conflictului din Transnistria.

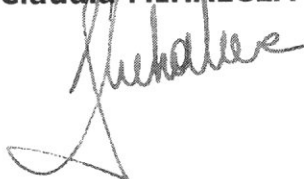
Acțiunile au caracter parlamentar conform art. 3, alin. a) din HBPr nr. 1/2003, modificată și completată prin HBPr nr. 5/2007.

Propunem:

- să se aprobe participarea domnului deputat Cezar Preda la acțiunile menționate;
- deplasarea să se efectueze cu avionul pe ruta București – Viena – Bonn – Viena – Paris – București cu plecare în data de 11 noiembrie 2017, ora 08:10 (OS 768) și întoarcere în data 16 noiembrie 2017, ora 16:15 (RO 382), conform traseului anexat și solicitării domnului deputat;
- să se acorde drepturi de diurnă categoria a II-a, 100%, pentru 5 ½ zile și cazare: pentru Bonn plafon B, pentru 3 nopți și pentru Paris plafon B, în numerar, pentru 2 nopți, conform solicitării acestuia;
- să se acorde un avans de 30% cu decontare ulterioară și, totodată, să se suporte din acesta eventuale alte taxe suplimentare precum taxele de oraș sau sejur percepute de hotel;
- să se suporte din bugetul Camerei Deputaților cheltuielile privind serviciile de asigurare contra accidentelor și asigurare de sănătate pentru domnul deputat în perioada efectivă de deplasare;

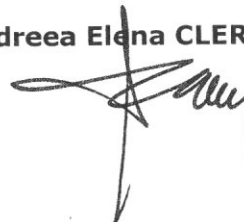

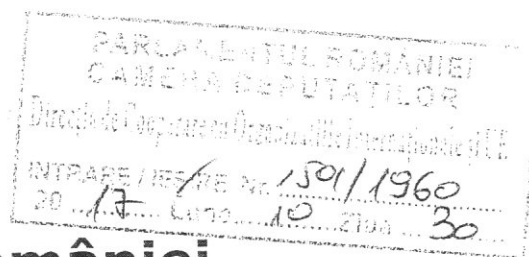

The twenty-third session of the Conference of the Parties to the United Nations Convention on Climate Change, commonly known as COP 23, will take place from 6 to 17 November 2017 in Bonn, Germany, under the presidency of Fiji. The session will be an event of global importance; the second one on the long road to practical implementation of the Paris Agreement concluded in December 2015.

We are pleased to announce that the IPU, the German Parliament and the Parliament of Fiji will jointly organize a Parliamentary Meeting on the occasion of COP 23 in Bonn. It will be a follow-up to the highly successful Parliamentary Meeting held in Marrakech, Morocco, in November 2016, and the adoption of the Parliamentary Action Plan on Climate Change (<http://www.ipu.org/english/surveys.htm#climat16>).

The Parliamentary Meeting at COP 23 will take place on 12 November 2017 on the premises of the University of Bonn. We are pleased to attach the draft programme and the registration form. These and other relevant documents will also soon be available on the IPU website. The languages of the meeting will be English and French.

The Meeting in Bonn will be held with a view to providing parliamentarians with an opportunity to obtain first-hand information on the main issues and orientations of COP 23, interact with experts and negotiators directly involved in the UNFCCC decision-making process, gain better knowledge of the recommendations included in the IPU's Parliamentary Action Plan on Climate Change and discuss ways of ensuring implementation of the Paris Agreement.

As on past occasions, the Meeting in Bonn is intended for parliamentarians who will attend the UNFCCC session as members of official national delegations. This is by far the easiest way to ensure that their transportation, visa, and accommodation needs are dealt with in a centralized way. More importantly, they will be automatically accredited to the UN Climate Change Conference and receive ID badges allowing them unrestricted access to COP 23 venues.

We therefore urge you to contact your country's relevant ministry without delay. The IPU, the German Parliament and the Parliament of Fiji are unfortunately not in a position to facilitate accreditation to the UN Climate Change Conference or assist with any logistical arrangements.

We hope that members of your parliament will take part in the forthcoming COP 23 session and will also attend the Parliamentary Meeting on 12 November.

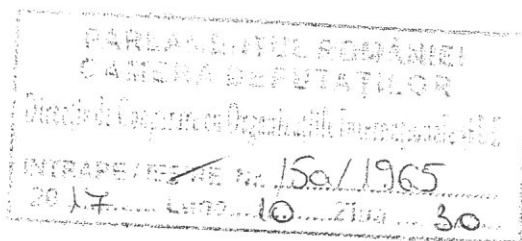
