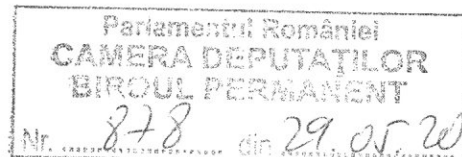

Tema: Participarea la reuniunea Comisiei pentru afaceri politice și democrație a Adunării Parlamentare a Consiliului Europei (Rønne, insula Bornholm, Danemarca, 14 – 15 iunie 2017)

În perioada 14 – 15 iunie 2017, la Rønne, insula Bornholm, Danemarca, vor avea loc lucrările Comisiei pentru afaceri politice și democrație a Adunării Parlamentare a Consiliului Europei (APCE), la care va participa domnul deputat **Attila Korodi (Lider Grup UDMR)**, membru al Comisiei APCE și al Delegației Parlamentului României la APCE.

În data de 14 iunie 2017, se vor desfășura lucrările Comisiei pentru afaceri politice și democrație, pe a cărei ordine de zi figurează spre dezbateră și adoptare o serie de rapoarte și rezoluții cu teme precum: corupția ca regim de guvernare: o barieră în calea eficienței și progresului instituțional; un răspuns umanitar și politic cuprinzător la criza migrației și a refugiaților din Europa; relațiile Consiliului Europei cu Kazahstan; evaluarea parteneriatului pentru democrație în ceea ce privește Parlamentul Iordanian; precum și situația din Siria și efectele în țările învecinate. Totodată, vor avea loc schimburi de vederi cu Ministrul afacerilor de externe danez, domnul Anders Samuelsen, cu Primarul din Bornholm, doamna Winnie Grosbøll, și cu Șeful delegației Parlamentului danez la APCE, domnul Michael Aastrup Jensen.

În data de 15 iunie 2017, membrii Comisiei APCE vor participa la Folkemødet, *Festivalul Politic al Danemarcei*: o întâlnire anuală la care participă parlamentari, miniștri, europarlamentari, primari și consilieri din Danemarca, dar și reprezentanți ai mai multor ONG-uri. Scopul festivalului este de a sprijini dialogul politic democratic și de a crea un cadru de întâlnire între factorii de decizie la toate nivelurile politice.

Acțiunea are caracter parlamentar conform art. 3, alin. a) din HBPr nr. 1/2003, modificată și completată prin HBPr nr. 5/2007.

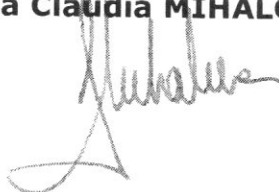
Propunem:

- să se aprobe participarea domnului deputat Attila Korodi la acțiunile menționate;

- deplasarea să se efectueze cu avionul, clasa economic, pe ruta București – Copenhaga și Copenhaga – Frankfurt – București, cu plecare în data de 13 iunie 2017, ora 15.05 (SK 1782) și întoarcere în data de 16 iunie 2017, la ora 17.40 (LH 1420), conform traseului anexat; menționăm că, pe tronsonul Copenhaga – Rønne (13 iunie) și Rønne – Copenhaga (15 iunie) zborurile sunt operate de companii low cost;
- să se suporte din bugetul Camerei Deputaților contravaloarea biletului de avion pe ruta Copenhaga – Rønne și retur, achiziționat de domnul deputat Attila Korodi din venituri proprii, în cuantum de maxim 500 euro, decontarea urmând a se face pe baza documentelor justificative (art.51 din HPBr 1/2003 cu modificările și completările ulterioare din HBPr 5/2007);
- să se acorde domnului deputat drepturi de diurnă categoria a II-a, 100% (majorată conform art.27, alin 2, lit. a din HPBr 1/2003 cu modificările și completările ulterioare din HBPr 5/2007) pentru 3 ½ zile și cazare plafon B pentru 2 nopți în Rønne și o noapte în Copenhaga;
- să se acorde un avans de 50% cu decontare ulterioară și, totodată, să se suporte din acesta eventuale alte taxe suplimentare precum taxele de oraș sau sejur percepute de hotel;
- să se suporte din bugetul Camerei Deputaților cheltuielile privind serviciile de asigurare contra accidentelor și asigurare de sănătate pentru domnului deputat, în perioada efectivă de deplasare;
- decontarea cheltuielilor să se facă la întoarcerea în țară, pe baza documentelor justificative.

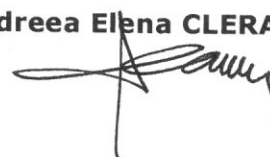

Folkemødet – The People's Political Festival

Denmark's Political Festival on the island of Bornholm in the Baltic Sea

Folkemødet is an annual meeting of the political parties, MPs, government ministers, MEPs, many mayors and councilors from all over Denmark, lots of people from every variety of associations and interest groups, where Bornholm provides the venue for Danish politicians to debate current political issues.



In 2016 a record number of people participated, 80.000 over the 4 days.

Concept and principles

The purpose of Folkemødet is:

- to support democratic dialogue
- creating the framework for meetings with and between decision-makers at all political levels and interest groups
- creating vibrant and open framework for the development of - and inspiration for policy-formation
- to promote the people's influence and understanding of society's framework

Open and free events

It is a Danish tradition that democracy is for everybody who wants to take part in it.

This tradition is the foundation of the Folkemøde concept.

Therefore, all legal Danish organizations, associations, businesses, as well as private living up to the principles for the events, have the same opportunity to join the program.

All events are free and within walking distance of each other.
