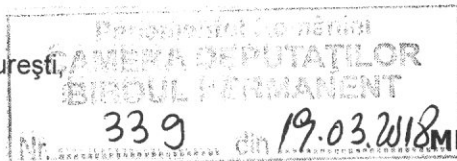

Tema: **Oportunitatea participării la Rețeaua Transatlantică a Tinerilor Parlamentari - TU40 (Washington D.C., 6 - 9 mai 2018)**

Directorul executiv al Rețelei Tinerilor Parlamentari din Parlamentul European - EU40, domnul **Adam Mouchtar**, și Directorul Biroului de legătură al Parlamentului European cu Congresul SUA, domnul **Antoine Ripoll**, au adresat o invitație membrilor cu vârsta de până în 40 de ani ai parlamentelor naționale din statele membre ale Uniunii Europene pentru participarea la reuniunea Rețelei Transatlantice a Tinerilor Parlamentari TU40, care se va desfășura la Washington D.C., în perioada 6 - 9 mai 2018.

Reuniunea Transatlantică a tinerilor parlamentari este prima acțiune care își propune să adune laolaltă tineri membri ai Parlamentului European, ai parlamentelor statelor membre UE și ai Congresului Statelor Unite ale Americii, cu scopul de a întări relații transatlantice.

Ultima acțiune pe linia Rețelei tinerilor parlamentari din Parlamentul European - EU40 a avut loc la Bruxelles, în luna noiembrie a anului trecut, iar Camera Deputaților a fost reprezentată de câte un tânăr parlamentar din partea fiecărui Grup parlamentar.

Până în prezent, la acțiunea de la Washington D.C., și-au exprimat dorința de participare tineri reprezentanți ai Grupului parlamentar al USR, care au primit invitații de participare, respectiv doamna deputat Lavinia Corina COSMA și domnii deputați Iulian BULAI, Mihai Cătălin BOTEZ și Lucian Daniel STANCIU VIZITEU.

Acțiunea are caracter parlamentar și este prevăzută în Programul anual de relații externe.

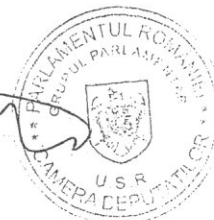
