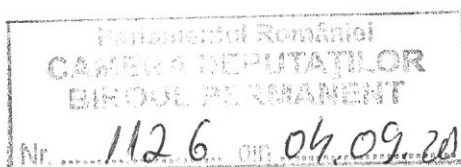

MEMORANDUM INTERN

De la: Silvia Claudia MIHALCEA, Secretar general al Camerei Deputaților**Către: Biroul Permanent al Camerei Deputaților****Tema: Primirea la Camera Deputaților a delegației Comisiei Parlamentului European pentru muncă și afaceri sociale (EMPL) (București, 18 septembrie 2018)**

În perioada 17 - 19 septembrie 2018, o delegație a Comisiei pentru muncă și afaceri sociale a Parlamentului European (EMPL) va efectua o vizită oficială în România.

Cu această ocazie, delegația Comisiei EMPL și-a manifestat dorința de a avea o întrevedere cu membrii Comisiilor parlamentare reunite ale Camerei Deputaților și Senatului pentru muncă și protecție socială și învățământ, tineret și sport, la Palatul Parlamentului, în ziua de **marți, 18 septembrie 2018, în intervalul orar 10:00-12:00**. În același interval este prevăzută și o vizită ghidată a Palatului Parlamentului.

În cadrul întâlnirii, membrii delegației Parlamentului European doresc să abordeze **situația din România privind locurile de muncă și impactul social, cu accent pe aspecte legate de: rata abandonului școlar timpuriu, tinerii aflați în afara sistemelor de educație, formare și ocupare profesională (NEET), egalitatea de gen la angajare, sărăcie și excluziune socială, inegalități privind veniturile, persoanele cu dizabilități pe piața muncii, integrarea romilor pe piața muncii.**

Delegația EMPL va examina aceste subiecte din perspectiva funcționării Fondului Social European și a activităților derulate în cadrul Inițiativei privind ocuparea forței de muncă în rândul tinerilor (YEI), studiind efectele privind locurile de muncă și cele sociale asupra liberei circulații a persoanelor în Uniunea Europeană din perspectiva țării de emigrație.

Față de cele de mai sus, **propunem:**

- întrevederea cu membrii Comisiilor reunite ale Parlamentului României pentru muncă și protecție socială și învățământ, tineret și sport să aibă loc în sala *Nicolae Iorga* care, împreună cu echipamentele necesare și asistența tehnică de specialitate, să fie puse la dispoziție în regim de gratuitate și să se asigure amenajarea corespunzătoare a acestora, inclusiv confecționarea de călăreți;

- să se asigure la întrevvedere fotografii, tratații etc.;
- accesul participanților în Palatul Parlamentului să se facă pe la intrarea C1;
- să se asigure un tur ghidat al Palatului Parlamentului pentru delegația EMPL;
- cheltuielile ocazionate de realizarea acestor întrevvederi să fie suportate din bugetul Camerei Deputaților.

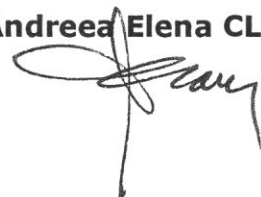

Dear Mr Solomon,

The European Parliament's Committee on Employment and Social Affairs (EMPL) of which I am the Acting Chair, will hold an official delegation visit to Romania from 17 to 19 September.

The purpose of the delegation is namely to examine the following issues with regard to the Romanian employment and social situation: early school leaving rate, NEET rate, gender employment gap, poverty and social exclusion, as well as income inequality, labour market performance, situation of the people with disabilities in the labour market, integration of Roma people in the labour market and active employment measures. The delegation would examine those matters in particular by inspecting the functioning of ESF and YEI activities in practice; studying the employment and social effects of free movement of persons in the EU from the perspective of a sending country. Meetings with social partners and other stakeholders are also foreseen.

The delegation, which will be composed of 6 Members of the Employment and Social Affairs Committee, would like to kindly request a meeting with you in your capacity of Chairperson of the Committee for Labour and Social Protection of the Chamber of Deputies of the Romanian Parliament to exchange on these issues.

We would like to propose that this meeting takes place on 18 September, between 10:00 and 12:00 if that is convenient for you. We would like to organise this meeting jointly with Ms Camelia Gavrilă, Chairperson of the Committee for Education, Science, Sport and Youth of the Chamber of Deputies of the Romanian Parliament, Mr Ion Rotaru, Chairperson of the Committee for Labour, Family and Social Protection of the Romanian Senate and Mr Liviu-Marian Pop,

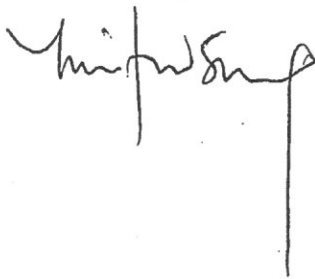
Chairperson of the Committee for Education, Science, Youth and Sport of the Romanian Senate.

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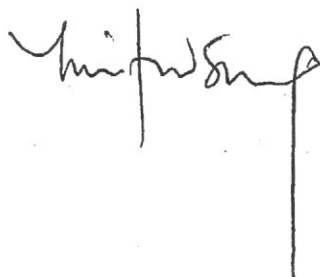
