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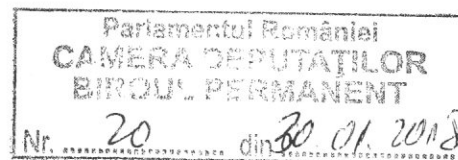

**Tema: Participarea la Forumul Global pentru Energie al Consiliului Atlantic
(Abu Dhabi, 12 - 13 ianuarie 2018)**

În perioada 12 - 13 ianuarie 2018, la Abu Dhabi, Emiratele Arabe Unite, va avea loc Forumul Global pentru Energie organizat de Consiliul Atlantic în colaborare cu Ministerul Energiei din Emiratele Arabe Unite și Consiliul Mondial pentru Energie, la care urmează să participe domnul deputat **Georgian POP (PSD)**, Secretar al Camerei Deputaților.

Pe agenda forumului figurează sesiuni de dezbatere pe următoarele teme: geopolitică regională și elemente fundamentale pentru energie: Europa, Asia; guvernanta Globală pentru Energie: dezvoltarea energetică, factor pentru prevenirea conflictelor; efectele geopolitice ale electrificării, digitalizării, inteligenței artificiale și ale securității cibernetice; viitorul transportului energiei; depozitarea petrolului; investițiile în petrol și gaze, într-un context de nesiguranță; riscuri geopolitice în contextul producției și comerțului de energiei; schimbări în politica pentru energie a SUA și repercusiunile pentru piețele globale de energie; descoperiri tehnologice în energie; schimbarea piețelor globale de Gaze Naturale Lichefiate; acordul nuclear cu Iranul: repercusiuni pentru investitori și piețe de energie; investiții în electrificare și energie regenerabilă; geopolitica și viitorul mobilității: impactul evoluțiilor în domeniile auto, transporturi și aviatice; impactul geopolitic al folosirii surselor alternative de energie – perspective 2035; perspective pentru viitorul energiei nucleare; perspective pentru viitorul energiei în Irak; diversitatea economică în regiunea Golfului; sectorul energetic în regiunea Golfului.

În cadrul lucrărilor forumului vor participa reprezentanți ai Consiliului Atlantic, ai unor importante organizații și agenții din domeniul energiei, precum și lideri ai marilor companii naționale și private din domeniu și reprezentanți ai mediului academic.

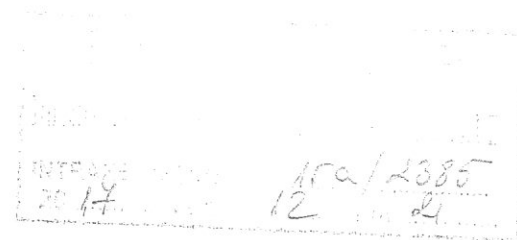
