



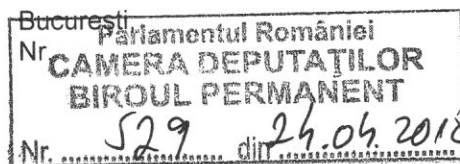

În perioada 6 - 9 mai 2018, la Washington D.C., Statele Unite ale Americii, va avea loc reuniunea Rețelei Transatlantice a Tinerilor Parlamentari – TU40, organizată de Rețeaua Tinerilor Parlamentari din Parlamentul European – EU40 și Biroul de legătură al Parlamentului European cu Congresul SUA.

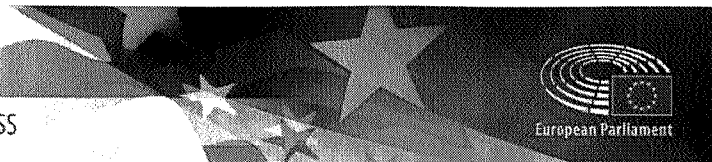

We, legislators, are facing unprecedented challenges and are operating in a permanently renewed political, but also social and economic environment. We belong to the new generation and have, maybe more than others, the duty to better understand the preoccupations and requests of our people. Some of these challenges are purely American or European, some are of a similar nature. All deserve to be discussed and addressed in the most efficient and human manner.

Historically natural and close allies, the United States of America and the European Union and its Member States have always operated through intensive cooperation.

Today, the transatlantic economy is the largest and most prosperous market in the world, representing over 35% of world GDP in terms of purchasing power. Serving as the leading source and destination for foreign direct investment between one another, the United States and Europe sustain and stimulate the transatlantic economy through mutual investment.

We are confident that this relationship is here to stay and to prosper.
