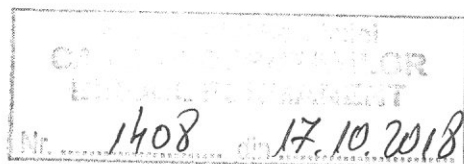

**Tema: Participarea la Forumul pentru Securitate de la Varșovia
(24 – 25 octombrie 2018)**

În perioada 24 - 25 octombrie 2018, NATO, împreună cu Biroul Național pentru Securitate al Președintelui Republicii Polone și Ministerul pentru Afaceri Externe al Republicii Polone, vor organiza **ediția din 2018 a Forumului pentru Securitate de la Varșovia**. Camera Deputaților a Parlamentului României va fi reprezentată la această acțiune de domnul deputat **Nicolae-Daniel POPESCU (USR)**, membru al Comisiei pentru apărare, ordine publică și siguranță națională.

Pe agenda reuniunii sunt prevăzute prezentări și dezbateri pe teme precum: **Îmbunătățirea democrației; Dezinformarea, războiul cibernetic, și ingineria socială – noi amenințări globale pentru democrație; Strategia de apărare și descurajare a NATO; UE și cea de-a patra Revoluție Industrială; Fenomenul migrației – confruntarea și cooperare; Protejarea infrastructurii critice; Postura de descurajare în Marea Baltică, Marea Neagră și în Marea Mediterană; Probabilitatea unui nou Război Mondial; Ideea unei Europe întregi și libere; UE și Balcanii de Vest; Războiul Rusia – Ucraina; Viitorul dezvoltării industriale și tehnologice în sectorul de apărare – importanța Fondului European pentru Apărare; Protecția spațiului aerian al Europei Centrale și de Est; Ameliorarea diferendelor dintre Vest și Est în UE; Relația Rusia – Occident .**

Printre participanții la Forum, îi amintim pe domnul **Mateusz Morawiecki**, Prim-ministrul Poloniei, domnul **Jacek Czaputowicz**, Ministru pentru Afaceri Externe al Poloniei, **Paweł Soloch**, Șeful Biroului pentru Securitate Națională al Poloniei, precum și oficiali ai NATO, reprezentanți ai mediului academic și experți internaționali.

Acțiunea are caracter parlamentar conform art. 3, alin. e) din HBPr nr. 1/2003, cu modificările și completările ulterioare.

Propunem:

- să se aprobe participarea domnului deputat la această acțiune;
- deplasarea să se efectueze cu avionul, clasa economică, pe ruta București – Varșovia - București, cu plecare în data de 23 octombrie 2018, ora 14:50 cu zborul LO 642 și întoarcere în data de 26 octombrie 2018, ora 01:25 cu zborul LO 643, conform itinerariului anexat;
- să se acorde drepturi de diurnă categoria a II-a, 100%, pentru 2 ½ zile și cazare plafon B pentru 2 nopți în numerar;
- să se acorde un avans de 20% cu decontare ulterioară și, totodată, să se suporte din acesta eventualele taxe de oraș percepute de hotel;
- să se suporte din bugetul Camerei Deputaților cheltuielile privind serviciile de asigurare contra accidentelor și asigurare de sănătate pentru domnul deputat, în perioada efectivă de deplasare;
- decontarea cheltuielilor să se facă la întoarcerea în țară, pe baza documentelor justificative.
