

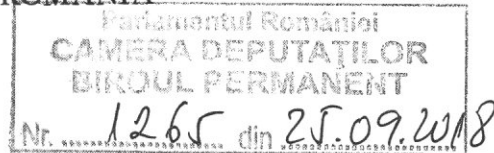

Tema: Participarea doamnei deputat Cristina-Mădălina Prună la Conferința cu tema „Echilibrul dintre cărbune și mediul înconjurător” (Bruxelles, 17 octombrie a.c.) și la cea de-a 18-a Reuniune interparlamentară EUFORES privind energia regenerabilă și eficiența energetică (Viena, Austria, 19-20 octombrie 2018)

În data de 17 octombrie 2018, va avea loc la Bruxelles, Conferința cu tema „Echilibrul dintre cărbune și mediul înconjurător: o tranziție energetică echitabilă”, organizată de publicația europeană Politico, în colaborare cu Asociația Electrică din Polonia (PKEE), la care doamna deputat **Cristina-Mădălina Prună (USR)**, membră a Comisiei pentru industrii și servicii a Camerei Deputaților, a fost invitată să participe și să aibă o intervenție.

Evenimentul va reuni importanți lideri politici, experți în domeniul afacerilor energetice, precum și reprezentanți ai societății civile, iar dezbaterile reuniunii se vor concentra pe subiecte privind *tranziția energetică echitabilă în diferite țări europene*.

De asemenea, Rețeaua parlamentară europeană – EUFORES, cu sprijinul Parlamentului din Austria și a Președinției austriece a Consiliului Uniunii Europene, organizează în perioada 19-20 octombrie 2018, cea de-a 18-a Reuniune interparlamentară EUFORES privind energia regenerabilă și eficiența energetică, la Viena, Austria, la care doamna deputat **Cristina-Mădălina Prună**, a fost invitată să participe în calitate de parlamentar și membru al rețelei parlamentare europene – EUFORES.

Dezbaterile reuniunii vor fi organizate în cadrul unei sesiuni plenare cu tema generală „Pachetul energiei curate pentru toți europenii – sursele regenerabile și eficiența energetică” și paneluri cu teme precum: „Sursele regenerabile de energie electrică – Importanța cooperării în Europa Centrală și de Sud-Est”; „Energia regenerabilă și eficiența energetică în sistemele de încălzire și răcire ale clădirilor”, etc.

Acțiunile au caracter parlamentar conform art. 3, lit. e) din HBPr 1/2003 cu modificările și completările ulterioare din HBPr 5/2007.

Propunem:

- să se aprobe participarea doamnei deputat Cristina-Mădălina Prună la acțiunile mai sus menționate;
- deplasarea să se efectueze cu avionul, clasa economic pe ruta București-Bruxelles, Bruxelles-Viena și Viena-București, cu plecare, în data de 17 octombrie a.c, zbor RO 371, ora 07.45 și întoarcere în data de 21 octombrie a.c., zbor RO 344, ora 20.20;
- să se acorde drepturi de diurnă categoria a II-a, 100% pentru 5 zile și drepturi de cazare, plafon B, pentru 1 noapte la Bruxelles (17-18 octombrie a.c.) și 3 nopți la Viena (18-21 octombrie a.c.), precum și un avans de 40% cu decontare ulterioară și, totodată, să se suporte din acesta eventuale alte taxe suplimentare precum taxele de oraș sau sejur percepute de hotel;
- să se suporte din bugetul Camerei Deputaților cheltuielile privind serviciile de asigurare contra accidentelor și asigurare de sănătate pentru perioada efectivă de deplasare;
- decontarea cheltuielilor se va face la întoarcerea în țară, pe baza documentelor justificative.

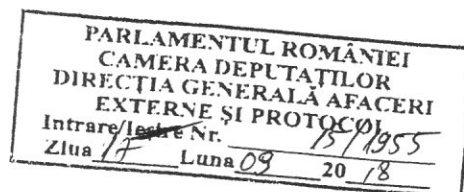
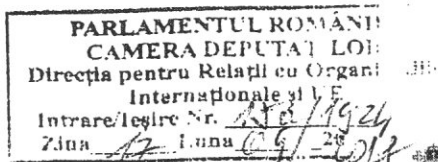

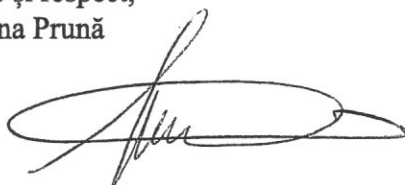

The discussion will focus on **what does "just" energy transition mean for the different European countries and how can the EU help coal regions to achieve this transition.** Please find attached a draft program for more information.

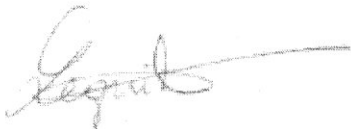

Balancing coal and climate: what is a "just" energy transition?

17 October, Brussels

The European Commission, in its new seven-year budget proposal, wants to boost climate spending in an effort to fight climate change and accelerate the EU energy transition. However, the EU has to deal with a tough reality. Today 41 regions in 12 EU countries are actively mining coal but many face significant economic and social challenges as the bloc shifts toward cleaner forms of energy.

While the Commission set up the "coal regions in transition" platform to help these regions modernize their economies and prepare for the structural and technological shift away from the fuel, there is still a long way to go. How can the EU ensure that no coal regions will be left behind while fighting climate change? Will the EU proposal to cut cohesion funding undermine the efforts of regions to shift away from coal towards a clean energy transition?

POLITICO is convening top policy-makers, business energy experts and civil society representatives for a frank discussion about what does "just" energy transition mean for the different European countries?

Key questions to be addressed include:

- What does the new EU budget mean for energy & climate spending? How should the money be spent to support the energy transition?
- What needs to be in the budget to propel the EU energy transition in a "just" way?
- Do the Commission's new spending priorities create divides between older and newer member countries, and what do these priorities mean for poorer countries in going green?
- How can the European Union speed-up the transition in coal dependent countries in a "just" way?
- Can fighting climate change co-exist with the gradual transition away from coal?
