Congratulations on your upcoming attendance at the **Senior Executive Seminar (18-11 SES), 04-Jun-18 to 08-Jun-18** at the George C. Marshall European Center for Security Studies. The Marshall Center Director, Lieutenant General (Ret) Keith Dayton, wishes to convey his greetings to you and looks forward with pleasure to your arrival in Garmisch-Partenkirchen. This letter and the attached information provide information that will be useful as you make your preparations to attend the Marshall Center.

Your travel to the Marshall Center will be arranged and funded by our Travel Office. Unless you request otherwise through your American Embassy point of contact, your travel arrangements will be made via commercial air. Your travel will be scheduled so you arrive at the Marshall Center on **02-Jun-18**. Registration will be on **03-Jun-18**. The course starts on **04-Jun-18** and ends on **08-Jun-18**. As flights are available, return travel will be arranged to depart Munich starting on the evening of **08-Jun-18**.

Due to constraints imposed by facilities and course funding you must attend the course in an unaccompanied status. Course participants will not be allowed to have overnight guests in the student hotel. This prohibition includes family members. Securing accommodations, visas, travel, etc. for visitors is entirely a private matter and the responsibility of the course participant.

We ask that, based upon your country's travel agreement with the German government, you ensure you have the proper travel documentation to attend the course, including a **Schengen Visa** if required. Please take this letter of confirmation, the visa support letter, the health insurance letter, and your passport to the German Embassy as soon as possible and apply for your **Schengen Visa valid from 31-May-18 to 10-Jun-18****The MC provides contracted emergency traveler's insurance to those students requiring a Schengen Visa, which will cover them for medical health / dental emergencies (non pre-existing conditions)******

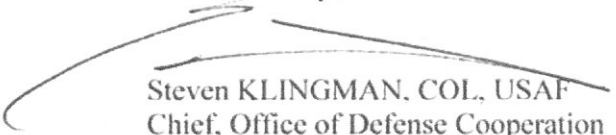
In order to prevent travel delays, course participants should immediately apply for their visas, if required. Please get these visas at the American and German Embassies prior to your arrival at the Marshall Center.

Based upon your selection to attend the **18-11 SES**, we ask that you make all arrangements necessary to be released from your national duties during your tenure at the Marshall Center. Please notify the American Embassy immediately if your status changes and you cannot attend this course.

Your stay in Garmisch-Partenkirchen will provide you with a unique opportunity to participate in a stimulating academic program and to meet highly accomplished officers and civilian officials from many other countries. As a course participant, your contributions are a valued portion of the seminars and the overall academic program. To maximize your experience, you are expected to participate in all lectures, seminars, exercises, field studies and course activities.
