Tema: Desemnarea de către Comitetul liderilor Grupurilor parlamentare a unei delegații a Camerei Deputaților pentru participarea la cea de-a 5-a ediție a Forumului Tinerilor Parlamentari (Viena, 22-23 noiembrie 2018)

Cea de-a 5-a ediție a **Forumului Tinerilor Parlamentari** se va desfășura în perioada 22 - 23 noiembrie 2018, la Viena, în contextul Președinției austriece a Consiliului Uniunii Europene. Evenimentul va fi co-organizat de Camera de Comerț a tinerilor din Austria și EU40 (rețeaua tinerilor membri ai Parlamentului European).

Proiectul de agendă transmis de organizatori cuprinde schimburi de vederi cu Cancelarul federal, Sebastian Kurz, parlamentari din partea gazdelor și reprezentanți ai mediului de afaceri din Austria. Dezbaterile se vor concentra în jurul unor teme de interes din domeniul economic precum: "Viena - centrul economiei austriece a tinerilor" sau "Este economia absurdă - rolul politicii, pieței muncii și al mediului de afaceri în alegerile europarlamentare din 2019".

La acest eveniment, legislativele naționale pot fi reprezentate de parlamentari cu vârsta de **cel mult patruzeci de ani**.

EU40 este o platformă trans-națională ce promovează o politică durabilă la nivel european menită să orienteze evoluțiile viitoare și să sprijine noile generații în identificarea celor mai bune soluții pentru viitor. Cu ocazia celei de-a 5-a ediții, tinerii parlamentari alături de reprezentanți ai executivului austriac și ai mediului economic, vor încerca să găsească soluții la principalele probleme cu care se confruntă mediul economic european actual.

Camera Deputaților a fost reprezentată la edițiile Forumului Tinerilor Parlamentari care s-au desfășurat la Paris, în perioada 18-19 septembrie 2018, și la Bruxelles, în perioada 7-8 noiembrie 2017.

Menționăm că acțiunea este prevăzută în Programul de relații externe al Camerei Deputaților pentru anul 2018 și are caracter parlamentar conform art. 3, lit. c) din HBPr 1/2003 modificată și completată prin HBPr 5/2007.

- Biroul permanent să transmită Comitetului liderilor Grupurilor parlamentare această invitație în vederea nominalizării unui reprezentant din partea majorității parlamentare și a unui reprezentant din partea opoziției, a căror vârstă să nu depășească patruzeci de ani;
- dat fiind timpul scurt până la derularea evenimentului, ca liderii grupurilor politice să transmită Direcției Generale Afaceri Externe și Protocol (cam.: 4157) cele două nominalizări, până la data de 7 noiembrie 2018, inclusiv.

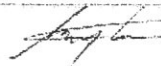

Henkel in Vienna is the regional Headquarters of Henkel company for Eastern Europe. Business operations has been started already in 1987 with a first joint venture in Hungary. Now, Eastern Europe stands for 2.897 bn EUR which is around 14 per cent of Henkel's global sales (2017). The Vienna plant for liquid laundry & home care products was established in 1927 and is based in the city center of Vienna, less than 2 kilometers away from St. Stephens Cathedral, the heart of Austria's capital. The plant is one of the biggest Henkel plants for Laundry & Home Care in Europe. 85 per cent of the production, amounting in total to approximately 250,000 tons per year, is exported to more than 20 countries in Eastern and Western Europe.
